- 1 Section 1. Section 237A.5, subsection 1, Code 2023, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- All personnel in licensed or registered facilities
- 4 shall have good health as evidenced by a report following a
- 5 preemployment physical examination taken within six months
- 6 prior to beginning employment or within thirty days following
- 7 the beginning of employment. The examination shall include
- 8 communicable disease tests by a licensed physician as defined
- 9 in section 135C.1 or a licensed physician assistant as defined
- 10 in section 148C.1 and shall be repeated every three years after
- 11 initial employment. Controlled medical conditions which would
- 12 not affect the performance of the employee in the capacity
- 13 employed shall not prohibit employment.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 17 This bill provides that all personnel of a licensed
- 18 or registered child care facility shall take a physical
- 19 examination to evidence good health within 6 months prior to
- 20 beginning employment or within 30 days following the beginning
- 21 of employment.
