- 7 729A.2 Violation of individual rights hate crime.
- 8 "Hate crime" means one of the following any public offenses
- 9 offense when committed against a person or a person's
- 10 property because of the person's race, color, religion,
- 11 ancestry, national origin, political affiliation, sex,
- 12 sexual orientation, age, or disability, or the person's
- 13 association with a person of a certain race, color, religion,
- 14 ancestry, national origin, political affiliation, sex, sexual
- 15 orientation, age, or disability. A hate crime shall be
- 16 classified and punished as an offense one degree higher than
- 17 the underlying offense.

- 31 Current law provides that "hate crime" means one of the

- 34 religion, ancestry, national origin, political affiliation,
- 35 sex, sexual orientation, age, or disability, or the person's

- 1 association with a person of a certain race, color, religion,
- 2 ancestry, national origin, political affiliation, sex, sexual
- 3 orientation, age, or disability: assault in violation of
- 4 individual rights under Code section 708.2C; violations of
- 5 individual rights under Code section 712.9; criminal mischief
- 6 in violation of individual rights under Code section 716.6A; or
- 7 trespass in violation of individual rights under Code section
- 8 716.8(3)(4).
- 9 The bill provides that "hate crime" means any public offense
- 10 when committed against a person or a person's property because
- 11 of the person's race, color, religion, ancestry, national
- 12 origin, political affiliation, sex, sexual orientation, age,
- 13 or disability, or the person's association with a person of
- 14 a certain race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin,
- 15 political affiliation, sex, sexual orientation, age, or
- 16 disability. A hate crime shall be classified and punished as
- 17 an offense one degree higher than the underlying offense.
- 18 The bill makes conforming Code changes.
