## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act establishing the national FFA organization advisors
- 2 competitive grant program within the department of education
- 3 and making appropriations.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **256.20 National FFA organization** 2 advisors competitive grant program fund appropriation.
- 3 1. The department shall establish a national FFA
- 4 organization advisors competitive grant program to provide
- 5 grants to school districts to help school districts offset
- 6 the cost associated with employing teachers licensed under
- 7 subchapter VII, part 3, who are involved in the national FFA
- 8 organization and who work extended contract hours as a result
- 9 of the teacher's involvement in the national FFA organization.
- 10 2. The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A
- 11 to administer this section, including rules relating to grant
- 12 application materials, eligibility requirements, and award
- 13 criteria.
- 3. Moneys awarded under this section shall be used to
- 15 supplement, not supplant, existing public funding used by a
- 16 school district for similar purposes.
- 4. A national FFA organization advisors competitive grant
- 18 program fund is established in the state treasury. The fund
- 19 shall be administered by the department and shall consist of
- 20 moneys appropriated by the general assembly and any other
- 21 moneys received by the department for deposit in the fund. The
- 22 moneys in the fund are appropriated to the department for the
- 23 national FFA organization advisors competitive grant program.
- 24 Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys in the fund that remain
- 25 unencumbered or unobligated at the close of a fiscal year
- 26 shall not revert but shall remain available for expenditure
- 27 for the purposes designated for subsequent fiscal years.
- 28 Notwithstanding section 12C.7, subsection 2, interest or
- 29 earnings on moneys in the fund shall be credited to the fund.
- 30 5. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and for each
- 31 fiscal year thereafter, there is transferred from the general
- 32 fund of the state to the national FFA organization advisors
- 33 competitive grant program fund the sum of five hundred thousand
- 34 dollars.

- 3 This bill establishes the national FFA organization advisors
- 4 competitive grant program within the department of education
- 5 (DE) to provide grants under the program to school districts
- 6 to help offset the cost associated with employing teachers
- 7 who are involved in the national FFA organization. The bill
- 8 requires DE to adopt rules to administer the program. The bill
- 9 provides that moneys awarded under the program shall be used
- 10 to supplement, not supplant, existing public funding used by a
- ll school district for similar purposes.
- 12 The bill establishes a national FFA organization advisors
- 13 competitive grant program fund and transfers \$500,000 from the
- 14 general fund of the state to this new fund each fiscal year
- 15 beginning in FY 2024-2025.
