A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to funding calculations for the teacher
- 2 salary supplement, professional development supplement,
- 3 early intervention supplement, and teacher leadership
- 4 supplement for school districts that materially breach an
- 5 interscholastic sharing agreement, and including effective
- 6 date and applicability provisions.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 257.10, subsection 9, paragraph c, 2 subparagraph (1), Code 2024, is amended to read as follows: (1) (a) The unadjusted teacher salary supplement district 3 4 cost is the teacher salary supplement district cost per pupil 5 for each school district for a budget year multiplied by the 6 sum of the budget enrollment for that school district plus the 7 number of resident pupils in the school district that received 8 an education savings account payment under section 257.11B for 9 the base year. (b) Notwithstanding subparagraph division (a), if a 10 11 district has materially breached an agreement created pursuant 12 to section 280.13A with an accredited nonpublic school prior 13 to the expiration of the agreement, without good cause, and 14 without mutual agreement of all parties to the agreement prior 15 to materially breaching the agreement, then the unadjusted 16 teacher salary supplement district cost is the teacher salary 17 supplement district cost per pupil for each school district for 18 a budget year multiplied by the sum of the budget enrollment 19 for that school district. 20 Sec. 2. Section 257.10, subsection 10, paragraph c, 21 subparagraph (1), Code 2024, is amended to read as follows: (1) (a) The unadjusted professional development supplement 22 23 district cost is the professional development supplement 24 district cost per pupil for each school district for a budget 25 year multiplied by the sum of the budget enrollment for that 26 school district plus the number of resident pupils in the 27 school district that received an education savings account 28 payment under section 257.11B for the base year. (b) Notwithstanding subparagraph division (a), if a 29 30 district has materially breached an agreement created pursuant 31 to section 280.13A with an accredited nonpublic school prior 32 to the expiration of the agreement, without good cause, and 33 without mutual agreement of all parties to the agreement prior 34 to materially breaching the agreement, then the unadjusted

- 4 Sec. 3. Section 257.10, subsection 11, paragraph c,
- 5 subparagraph (1), Code 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (1) (a) The unadjusted early intervention supplement
- 7 district cost is the early intervention supplement district
- 8 cost per pupil for each school district for a budget year
- 9 multiplied by the sum of the budget enrollment for that school
- 10 district plus the number of resident pupils in the school
- 11 district that received an education savings account payment
- 12 under section 257.11B for the base year.
- 13 (b) Notwithstanding subparagraph division (a), if a
- 14 district has materially breached an agreement created pursuant
- 15 to section 280.13A with an accredited nonpublic school prior
- 16 to the expiration of the agreement, without good cause, and
- 17 without mutual agreement of all parties to the agreement prior
- 18 to materially breaching the agreement, then the unadjusted
- 19 early intervention supplement district cost is the early
- 20 intervention supplement district cost per pupil for each school
- 21 district for a budget year multiplied by the sum of the budget
- 22 enrollment for that school district.
- 23 Sec. 4. Section 257.10, subsection 12, paragraph c,
- 24 subparagraph (1), Code 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 25 (1) (a) The unadjusted teacher leadership supplement
- 26 district cost is the teacher leadership supplement district
- 27 cost per pupil for each school district for a budget year
- 28 multiplied by the sum of the budget enrollment for that school
- 29 district plus the number of resident pupils in the school
- 30 district that received an education savings account payment
- 31 under section 257.11B for the base year.
- 32 (b) Notwithstanding subparagraph division (a), if a
- 33 district has materially breached an agreement created pursuant
- 34 to section 280.13A with an accredited nonpublic school prior
- 35 to the expiration of the agreement, without good cause, and

- 1 without mutual agreement of all parties to the agreement prior
- 2 to materially breaching the agreement, then the unadjusted
- 3 teacher leadership supplement district cost is the teacher
- 4 leadership supplement district cost per pupil for each school
- 5 district for a budget year multiplied by the sum of the budget
- 6 enrollment for that school district.
- 7 Sec. 5. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to school districts
- 8 that materially breach an agreement created pursuant to section
- 9 280.13A with an accredited nonpublic school prior to the
- 10 expiration of the agreement, without good cause, and without
- 11 mutual agreement of all parties to the agreement prior to
- 12 materially breaching the agreement on or after the effective
- 13 date of this Act.
- 14 Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 15 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 16 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 19 This bill relates to funding calculations for the teacher
- 20 salary supplement, professional development supplement, early
- 21 intervention supplement, and teacher leadership supplement for
- 22 school districts that materially breach an interscholastic
- 23 sharing agreement.
- 24 For the purposes of funding the teacher salary supplement,
- 25 professional development supplement, early intervention
- 26 supplement, and teacher leadership supplement, school
- 27 districts are allowed to count resident students who receive an
- 28 education savings account payment (ESA students) in the funding
- 29 calculation.
- 30 The bill prohibits a school district from counting ESA
- 31 students in its funding calculations for the teacher salary
- 32 supplement, professional development supplement, early
- 33 intervention supplement, and teacher leadership supplement if
- 34 the school district has materially breached an interscholastic
- 35 sharing agreement with an accredited nonpublic school prior

- 1 to the agreement's expiration without good cause and without
- 2 mutual agreement of the parties that entered into the
- 3 agreement.
- 4 The bill applies to school districts that materially breach
- 5 an agreement created pursuant to Code section 280.13A with an
- 6 accredited nonpublic school prior to the expiration of the
- 7 agreement, without good cause, and without mutual agreement of
- 8 all parties to the agreement prior to breaking the agreement on
- 9 or after the effective date of the bill.
- 10 The bill is effective upon enactment.
