SENATE FILE 2040 BY COURNOYER

A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to animal welfare special registration plates.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 162.2C, subsections 2 and 3, Code 2024,
- 2 are amended to read as follows:
- 3 2. The fund shall include moneys collected by the department
- 4 in fees as provided in section 162.2B, moneys transferred
- 5 pursuant to section 321.34, subsection 28, and moneys
- 6 appropriated by the general assembly. The fund may include
- 7 other moneys available to and obtained or accepted by the
- 8 department, including moneys from public or private sources.
- 9 3. a. Moneys in the fund are appropriated to the department
- 10 and shall be used exclusively to carry out the provisions of
- 11 this chapter as determined and directed by the department, and
- 12 shall not require further special authorization by the general
- 13 assembly.
- 14 b. The department shall use moneys in the fund transferred
- 15 pursuant to section 321.34, subsection 28, to increase the
- 16 frequency of inspections authorized under section 162.10B.
- 17 Sec. 2. Section 321.34, Code 2024, is amended by adding the
- 18 following new subsection:
- 19 NEW SUBSECTION. 28. Animal welfare plates.
- 20 a. An owner referred to in subsection 12 may, upon written
- 21 application to the department, order special registration
- 22 plates with an animal welfare distinguishing processed emblem.
- 23 b. The animal welfare emblem shall depict a black cat nested
- 24 within a white dog, nested within a black paw print.
- c. The special animal welfare fee for letter-number
- 26 designated animal welfare plates is thirty-five dollars. An
- 27 applicant may obtain personalized animal welfare plates as
- 28 described in subsection 12, paragraph "c".
- 29 d. The fees collected by the director under this subsection,
- 30 and the fees collected by the director under subsection 12,
- 31 paragraph "a", from the annual validation of letter-number
- 32 designated animal welfare plates, and subsection 12, paragraph
- 33 "c", from the issuance and annual validation of personalized
- 34 animal welfare plates, shall be paid monthly to the treasurer
- 35 of state and deposited in the road use tax fund. The treasurer

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- 1 of state shall transfer monthly from the statutory allocations
- 2 fund created under section 321.145, subsection 2, to the
- 3 commercial establishment fund created in section 162.2C the
- 4 amount of the special fees collected in the previous month for
- 5 animal welfare plates.
- 6 e. The department shall not condition the issuance of animal
- 7 welfare plates on the receipt of any number of orders for
- 8 animal welfare plates.
- 9 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 12 Under current law, the owner of a vehicle subject to
- 13 registration may apply to the department of transportation
- 14 (DOT) to order special registration plates with a
- 15 distinguishing processed emblem authorized by Code section
- 16 321.34 or approved by the DOT. Personalized processed emblem
- 17 special registration plates are limited to five or fewer
- 18 numerals and letters. This bill authorizes the DOT to design
- 19 and issue special registration plates with an animal welfare
- 20 distinguishing processed emblem. The bill requires the DOT to
- 21 design the animal welfare emblem, which must depict a black cat
- 22 nested within a white dog, nested within a black paw print.
- 23 Under current law, the default special fee for a special
- 24 registration plate with a distinguishing processed emblem
- 25 is \$25. However, the bill provides that the special animal
- 26 welfare fee for letter-number designated animal welfare plates
- 27 is \$35. Pursuant to current law, an applicant may obtain
- 28 personalized animal welfare plates upon payment of the \$25 fee
- 29 for personalized plates, which is in addition to the special
- 30 animal welfare fee. Pursuant to current law, the annual
- 31 special animal welfare fee for letter-number designated plates
- 32 is \$5, which is in addition to the regular annual registration
- 33 fee, and the annual fee for personalized animal welfare plates
- 34 is \$5, which is in addition to the annual special animal
- 35 welfare fee and the regular annual registration fee.

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- 1 The fees collected by the DOT must be paid monthly to the
- 2 treasurer of state and deposited in the road use tax fund. The
- 3 treasurer of state must transfer monthly from the statutory
- 4 allocations fund to the commercial establishment fund the
- 5 amount of the special fees collected in the previous month for
- 6 animal welfare plates.
- 7 Under the current law, the department of agriculture and
- 8 land stewardship (DALS) is responsible for regulating the
- 9 care of animals in commercial establishments pursuant to Code
- 10 chapter 162. "Commercial establishment" is defined in Code
- 11 chapter 162 as an animal shelter, boarding kennel, commercial
- 12 breeder, commercial kennel, dealer, pet shop, pound, public
- 13 auction, or research facility. The bill requires DALS to use
- 14 the moneys deposited in the commercial establishment fund
- 15 from animal welfare plate fees to increase the frequency of
- 16 inspections authorized under Code section 162.10B. Pursuant
- 17 to Code section 162.10B, DALS may inspect the commercial
- 18 establishment of a registrant or state licensee by entering
- 19 onto its business premises at any time during normal working
- 20 hours. In addition, DALS may inspect records required to be
- 21 maintained by the state licensee or registrant.
- 22 The bill prohibits the DOT from conditioning the issuance of
- 23 animal welfare plates on the receipt of any number of orders
- 24 for animal welfare plates.
