## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to voter registration activities at schools.
 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 48A.23, subsection 1, Code 2023, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. At least twice during each school year, the board of 4 directors of each school district operating a high school and 5 the authorities in charge of each accredited nonpublic school 6 shall offer the opportunity to register to vote to each student 7 who is at least seventeen years of age <u>as provided in this</u> 8 subsection.

9 a. The board of directors of each school district operating 10 a high school and the authorities in charge of each accredited 11 nonpublic school shall allow each student who is at least 12 seventeen years of age to register to vote during school hours 13 on the fourth Tuesday in September of each year, or on the next 14 available school day if school is not in session on that day. 15 b. The board of directors of each school district operating 16 a high school and the authorities in charge of each accredited 17 nonpublic school shall coordinate with the commissioner of 18 registration to organize a second opportunity to allow each 19 student who is at least seventeen years of age to register to 20 vote during school hours, which shall occur later than the 21 date provided in paragraph  $a^{a}$ , and shall be conducted by the 22 commissioner or the commissioner's designee. 23 The state registrar of voters shall prepare materials C. 24 regarding voter registration to be distributed at each voter 25 registration activity conducted pursuant to this subsection. 26 d. The board of directors of each school district 27 operating a high school and the authorities in charge of each 28 accredited nonpublic school shall file a report regarding voter 29 registration activities conducted pursuant to this section with 30 the department of education by December 31 of each year. EXPLANATION 31 32 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 33 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. 34 This bill relates to voter registration activities conducted

35 at schools. The bill requires the board of directors of each

1 school district operating a high school and the authorities in 2 charge of each accredited nonpublic school to allow students 3 who are at least 17 years of age to register to vote during 4 school hours on the fourth Tuesday in September of each year, 5 or on the next available school day if school is not in session 6 on that day, and on a second day after that date. The second 7 voter registration opportunity shall be conducted by the county 8 commissioner of registration or the commissioner's designee. 9 The bill requires the state registrar of voters to prepare 10 materials to be distributed at each such voter registration ll opportunity. The bill also requires the board of directors 12 of each school district operating a high school and the 13 authorities in charge of each accredited nonpublic school to 14 file a report regarding voter registration activities with the 15 department of education by December 31 of each year.
