## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act allowing area education agencies to charge user fees to
- 2 nonpublic schools for materials and services provided.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## S.F. 2050

- 1 Section 1. Section 273.3, Code 2024, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 19A. Pursuant to rules adopted by the
- 4 state board of education, be authorized to charge an accredited
- 5 nonpublic school a user fee for any materials and services
- 6 provided to the accredited nonpublic school or its students,
- 7 including services and programs as provided in sections
- 8 273.1, 273.2, this section, sections 273.4 through 273.8, and
- 9 chapter 256B, in an amount not to exceed the actual cost of the
- 10 materials and services provided.
- 11 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 14 Area education agencies (AEAs) were created in order
- 15 to provide effective, efficient, and economical means of
- 16 identifying and serving children who require special education
- 17 by providing media services and other programs to K-12 pupils.
- 18 Services and materials required of AEAs by statute or rule are
- 19 funded by payments from school districts through the state
- 20 school foundation aid the school district receives for its
- 21 children requiring special education. AEAs are allowed to
- 22 charge a fee for services and materials a public or nonpublic
- 23 school requests the AEA to provide, but which AEAs are not
- 24 required to provide by statute or rule.
- 25 This bill allows AEAs to charge an accredited nonpublic
- 26 school a user fee for materials and services provided to the
- 27 accredited nonpublic school or its students in an amount not to
- 28 exceed the actual cost of the materials and services provided
- 29 for all services that the AEA provides.
