## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act establishing a nursing home administrator training pilot
- 2 program.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

TLSB 5579XS (5) 90 pf/ko 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 155.20 Nursing home administrator 2 training pilot program.

1. The department of inspections, appeals, and licensing shall establish a nursing home administrator training pilot program to provide opportunities for individuals pursuing the profession of nursing home administrator, prior to an individual receiving a nursing home administrator license, to obtain on-the-job experience supervised by a licensed nursing home administrator.

10 2. An applicant for the pilot program shall provide evidence 11 of all of the following to the department:

12 a. Compliance with section 155.3, subsections 1 and 2.
13 b. An offer of employment from a participating nursing home
14 in the state that has received a minimum overall rating of
15 three stars from the five-star quality rating system created by
16 the centers for Medicare and Medicaid services of the United
17 States department of health and human services.

18 c. The name of the participating nursing home at which the 19 applicant will be employed and receive training, and the name 20 of the participating nursing home administrator who will act 21 as the applicant's supervisor during the pilot program. The 22 participating nursing home administrator shall hold a current 23 license in good standing as a nursing home administrator, have 24 at least two years of experience, and shall not be related 25 to the applicant within the third degree of consanguinity or 26 affinity.

3. a. Upon acceptance into the pilot program, the nursing home administrator trainee shall work in the participating nursing home under the supervision of the participating nursing home administrator for a minimum of two consecutive years.

*b.* During the training period, the board shall grant the trainee a provisional license, and shall waive the examination requirements pursuant to section 155.3 and any continuing deducation requirements prescribed by the board under section 155.10.

c. Subject to the availability of funds appropriated to
 the department of inspections, appeals, and licensing for the
 purpose of the pilot program:

4 (1) The department shall consider approving up to ten5 applicants in the first year of the pilot program.

6 (2) The department shall reimburse a participating nursing 7 home for thirty percent of the trainee's base salary during 8 the first year, not to exceed thirty thousand dollars, and ten 9 percent of the trainee's base salary during the second year, 10 not to exceed ten thousand dollars.

11 d. If a trainee is terminated by the participating nursing 12 home for cause, the trainee shall refund to the department 13 the portion of the trainee's base salary reimbursed by the 14 department.

4. Upon completion of the training period, the participating nursing facility shall submit verification to the board that the trainee is in good professional standing and shall report any unprofessional conduct or disciplinary action y taken against the trainee during the training period.

5. Notwithstanding any other required qualifications for licensure, upon completion of the training period and payment of the license fee pursuant to section 155.5, the trainee shall be eligible for licensure as a nursing home administrator.

6. The department shall adopt rules to administer the pilot program, including criteria for designating a nursing home as a participating nursing home and a nursing home administrator as a participating nursing home administrator.

7. The department of inspections, appeals, and licensing shall submit a report to the general assembly by December 30 31, 2026, that provides an assessment of the pilot program 31 and a recommendation to continue the pilot program, continue 32 the pilot program with modifications, or terminate the pilot 33 program.

34 Sec. 2. Section 155.9, Code 2024, is amended to read as 35 follows:

2 In addition to the duties and responsibilities provided in
3 chapters 147 and 272C, the board shall adopt rules for granting
4 a <u>nursing home administrator</u> provisional license to <u>under the</u>
5 following circumstances:

6 <u>1. To</u> an administrator appointed on a temporary basis by 7 a nursing home's owner or owners in the event the regular 8 administrator of the nursing home is unable to perform the 9 administrator's duties or the nursing home is without a 10 licensed administrator because of death or other cause. Such 11 provisional license shall allow the provisional licensee 12 to perform the duties of a nursing home administrator. An 13 individual shall not hold a provisional license for more than 14 twelve total combined months, and the board may revoke or 15 otherwise discipline a provisional licensee for cause after due 16 notice and a hearing on a charge or complaint filed with the 17 board.

18 <u>2. To a nursing home administrator trainee while</u> 19 <u>participating in the nursing home administrator training pilot</u> 20 <u>program established under section 155.20.</u> 21 EXPLANATION

22 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 23 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

This bill requires the department of inspections, appeals, and licensing (DIAL) to establish a nursing home administrator training pilot program (pilot program) to provide opportunities for individuals pursuing the profession of nursing home administrator, prior to an individual receiving a nursing home administrator license, to obtain on-the-job experience supervised by a licensed nursing home administrator.

31 An applicant for the pilot program shall provide evidence 32 to DIAL of: compliance with the requirements for an applicant 33 for a nursing home administrator license to be of sound mental 34 health and physically able to perform the duties and to have 35 presented satisfactory evidence of sufficient education,

LSB 5579XS (5) 90 pf/ko 1 training, or experience to administer, supervise, and manage 2 a nursing home; an offer of employment from a participating 3 nursing home in the state that has received a minimum overall 4 rating of three stars from the federal five-star quality rating 5 system; the name of the participating nursing home in which 6 the applicant will be employed and train; and the name of the 7 participating nursing home administrator who will act as the 8 applicant's supervisor during the pilot program.

9 Upon acceptance into the pilot program, the nursing home 10 administrator trainee shall work in the participating nursing 11 facility under the supervision of a participating nursing 12 home administrator for a minimum of two consecutive years. 13 During the training period, the board shall grant the trainee a 14 provisional license and waive the examination requirements and 15 any continuing education requirements prescribed by the board. 16 Subject to the availability of funds appropriated to DIAL 17 for the purpose of the pilot program: DIAL shall consider 18 approving up to 10 applicants in the first year of the pilot 19 program; and DIAL shall reimburse the participating nursing 20 home for 30 percent of the trainee's base salary during the 21 first year, not to exceed \$30,000, and 10 percent of the 22 trainee's base salary during the second year, not to exceed 23 \$10,000. If a trainee is terminated by the participating 24 nursing home for cause, the trainee shall refund to DIAL the 25 portion of the trainee's base salary reimbursed by DIAL.

26 Upon completion of the training period, the participating 27 nursing home shall submit verification to the board that the 28 trainee is in good professional standing and shall report any 29 unprofessional conduct or disciplinary action taken against the 30 trainee during the training period.

Notwithstanding any other required qualifications for licensure, upon completion of the training period and payment of the license fee, the trainee shall be eligible for licensure as a nursing home administrator. The bill directs DIAL to adopt administrative rules to administer the pilot program.

LSB 5579XS (5) 90 pf/ko 1 The bill requires DIAL to submit a report to the general 2 assembly by December 31, 2026, with an assessment of the pilot 3 program and a recommendation to continue the pilot program, 4 continue the pilot program with modifications, or terminate the 5 pilot program.

6 The bill makes a conforming change in Code section 155.9 7 to authorize the board to adopt rules to grant a nursing 8 home administrator provisional license to a nursing home 9 administrator trainee while participating in the pilot program.
