- 1 Section 1. Section 724.15, subsection 1, Code 2024, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 1. It is the intent of this section to satisfy federal
- 4 requirements of 18 U.S.C. §922(t)(3) in order to acquire
- 5 pistols or revolvers. In order to acquire a pistol or revolver
- 6 from a federally licensed firearms dealer, an unlicensed any
- 7 other person, and in order to provide proof of a background
- 8 check and notify that the purchaser is of legal age, a person
- 9 is required to have a valid permit to acquire or a valid permit
- 10 to carry weapons issued in accordance with this chapter or the
- 11 person must complete a satisfactory national instant criminal
- 12 background check pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §922(t).
- 13 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

- 18 Current law provides that an unlicensed person acquiring a
- 19 pistol or revolver from a federally licensed firearms dealer
- 20 is required to have a valid permit to acquire or a valid permit
- 21 to carry weapons issued under the provisions of Code chapter
- 22 724 or the person must complete a satisfactory national instant
- 23 criminal background check pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §922(t).

- 25 a pistol or revolver from any other person, and in order
- 26 to provide proof of a background check and notify that the
- 27 purchaser is of legal age, a person is required to have a valid
- 28 permit to acquire or a valid permit to carry weapons issued
- 29 under the provisions of Code chapter 724 or the person must
- 30 complete a satisfactory national instant criminal background
- 31 check pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §922(t).
