A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to emergency medical services special
- 2 registration plates.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- Section 1. Section 321.34, subsection 10A, paragraph a, 2 Code 2024, is amended to read as follows:

 a. The owner of a motor vehicle referred to in subsection 4 12 who is a current member of a paid or volunteer emergency
- 5 medical services agency may, upon written application to the
- 6 department, order special registration plates, designed by the
- 7 department in cooperation with representatives designated by
- 8 the Iowa emergency medical services association, which plates
- 9 to signify that the applicant is a current member of a paid
- 10 or volunteer emergency medical services agency. The plate's
- 11 background shall be white and the plate's letters and numbers
- 12 shall be blue. The left side of the plate shall depict a
- 13 blue, six-pointed star with a white serpent and staff in the
- 14 middle, commonly referred to as the star of life. The letters
- 15 "EMS" shall appear on the bottom of the plate. The application
- 16 shall be approved by the department, in consultation with
- 17 representatives designated by the Iowa emergency medical
- 18 services association, and the special registration plates shall
- 19 be issued to the applicant in exchange for the registration
- 20 plates previously issued to the person. The fee for the
- 21 special plates is twenty-five dollars which is in addition to
- 22 the regular annual registration fee. The department shall
- 23 validate the special plates in the same manner as regular
- 24 registration plates are validated under this section at the
- 25 regular annual registration fee.
- 26 Sec. 2. Section 321.166, subsections 2 and 9, Code 2024, are
- 27 amended to read as follows:
- 28 2. Every registration plate or pair of plates shall display
- 29 a registration plate number which shall consist of alphabetical
- 30 or numerical characters or a combination thereof and the name
- 31 of this state, which may be abbreviated. Every registration
- 32 plate issued by the county treasurer shall display the name
- 33 of the county, including any plate issued pursuant to section
- 34 321.34, except Pearl Harbor and purple heart registration
- 35 plates issued prior to January 1, 1997; and collegiate,

- 1 fire fighter, emergency medical services, and medal of honor 2 registration plates. Special truck registration plates shall 3 display the word "special". The department may adopt rules to 4 implement this subsection. 9. Special registration plates issued pursuant to section 6 321.34, other than gold star, medal of honor, collegiate, 7 fire fighter, emergency medical services, natural resources, 8 blackout, and flying our colors registration plates, shall be 9 consistent with the design and color of regular registration 10 plates but shall provide a space on a portion of the plate 11 for the purpose of allowing the placement of a distinguishing 12 processed emblem or an organization decal. Special 13 registration plates shall also comply with the requirements 14 for regular registration plates as provided in this section to 15 the extent the requirements are consistent with the section 16 authorizing a particular special vehicle registration plate. 17 Sec. 3. TRANSITION. A person applying for new or 18 replacement emergency medical services special registration 19 plates on or after the effective date of this Act shall receive 20 plates designed as described in this Act. The department of 21 transportation shall issue plates as described in this Act to 22 owners who were issued emergency medical services plates prior 23 to the effective date of this Act upon the next renewal of the 24 owner's registration if the owner chooses to retain emergency 25 medical services plates.
- 26 **EXPLANATION**
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 27 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. 28
- 29 Under current law, the department of transportation (DOT) is 30 authorized to issue emergency medical services (EMS) special 31 registration plates to the owner of a vehicle who is a current 32 member of a paid or volunteer EMS agency. The DOT designed the 33 plate in cooperation with representatives designated by the 34 Iowa EMS association.
- 35 This bill instead requires the plate's background to be

- 1 white and the plate's letters and numbers to be blue. The left
- 2 side of the plate must depict the star of life. The letters
- 3 "EMS" must appear on the bottom of the plate.
- 4 The bill exempts EMS plates from the general requirements
- 5 to display the name of the county that issues the registration
- 6 plates and to be consistent with the design and color of
- 7 regular registration plates.
- 8 The bill provides transition provisions.
