## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to harassment and extortion involving a person
- whose image was used in creating, adapting, or modifying a
- 3 photograph or film, and making penalties applicable.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

#### S.F. 2186

- 1 Section 1. Section 708.7, subsection 1, paragraph a,
- 2 subparagraph (5), Code 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 (5) Disseminates, publishes, distributes, posts, or
- 4 causes to be disseminated, published, distributed, or posted a
- 5 photograph or film showing another person in a state of full or
- 6 partial nudity or engaged in a sex act, knowing that the other
- 7 person has not consented to the dissemination, publication,
- 8 distribution, or posting. For purposes of this subparagraph,
- 9 "another person" includes a person whose image was used in
- 10 creating, adapting, or modifying a photograph or film with
- 11 the intent to depict that other person who is recognizable
- 12 by the person's face, likeness, or other distinguishing
- 13 characteristic.
- 14 Sec. 2. Section 708.7, Code 2024, is amended by adding the
- 15 following new subsection:
- 16 NEW SUBSECTION. 7A. A person who commits a violation of
- 17 subsection 1, paragraph "a", subparagraph (5), that results in
- 18 the victim of the violation committing suicide, in addition to
- 19 the penalties provided in subsection 2, may be charged with
- 20 involuntary manslaughter under section 707.5.
- 21 Sec. 3. Section 711.4, subsection 1, Code 2024, is amended
- 22 by adding the following new paragraph:
- 23 NEW PARAGRAPH. h. Threatens to disseminate, publish,
- 24 distribute, or post a photograph or film showing another
- 25 person in a state of full or partial nudity or engaged in a
- 26 sex act, knowing that the other person has not consented to
- 27 the dissemination, publication, distribution, or posting. For
- 28 purposes of this subsection, "another person" includes a person
- 29 whose image was used in creating, adapting, or modifying a
- 30 photograph or film with the intent to depict that other person
- 31 who is recognizable by the person's face, likeness, or other
- 32 distinguishing characteristic.
- 33 Sec. 4. Section 711.4, Code 2024, is amended by adding the
- 34 following new subsection:
- 35 NEW SUBSECTION. 5. A person who commits a violation of

- 1 subsection 1, paragraph "h", that results in the victim of the
- 2 violation committing suicide, in addition to the penalties
- 3 provided in subsection 2, may be charged with involuntary
- 4 manslaughter under section 707.5.
- 5 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 8 This bill relates to harassment and extortion involving a
- 9 person whose image was used in creating, adapting, or modifying
- 10 a photograph or film.
- 11 Under current Code section 708.7(1)(a)(5), a person
- 12 commits harassment when, with intent to intimidate, annoy,
- 13 or alarm another person, the person disseminates, publishes,
- 14 distributes, posts, or causes to be disseminated, published,
- 15 distributed, or posted a photograph or film showing another
- 16 person in a state of full or partial nudity or engaged in a sex
- 17 act, knowing that the other person has not consented to the
- 18 dissemination, publication, distribution, or posting.
- 19 The bill provides that for purposes of the above provision,
- 20 "another person" includes a person whose image was used in
- 21 creating, adapting, or modifying a photograph or film with
- 22 the intent to depict that other person who is recognizable
- 23 by the person's face, likeness, or other distinguishing
- 24 characteristic.
- A violation of Code section 708.7(1)(a)(5) is an aggravated
- 26 misdemeanor. An aggravated misdemeanor is punishable by
- 27 confinement for no more than two years and a fine of at least
- 28 \$855 but not more than \$8,540.
- 29 The bill provides that, in addition to the above penalties,
- 30 a person who commits a violation of Code section 708.7(1)(a)(5)
- 31 that results in the victim of the violation committing suicide
- 32 may be charged with involuntary manslaughter.
- The bill provides that a person commits extortion with the
- 34 purpose of obtaining for oneself or another anything of value,
- 35 tangible or intangible, including labor or services, if the

- 1 person threatens to disseminate, publish, distribute, or post a
- 2 photograph or film showing another person in a state of full or
- 3 partial nudity or engaged in a sex act, knowing that the other
- 4 person has not consented to the dissemination, publication,
- 5 distribution, or posting. The bill provides that "another
- 6 person" includes a person whose image was used in creating,
- 7 adapting, or modifying a photograph or film with the intent to
- 8 depict that other person who is recognizable by the person's
- 9 face, likeness, or other distinguishing characteristic.
- 10 Extortion is a class "D" felony. A class "D" felony is
- 11 punishable by confinement for no more than five years and a
- 12 fine of at least \$1,025 but not more than \$10,245.
- The bill provides that a person who commits a violation
- 14 of Code section 711.4(5)(h) that results in the victim of
- 15 the violation committing suicide may also be charged with
- 16 involuntary manslaughter.
