Section 1. Section 20.3, subsection 11, Code 2023, is
amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. *g*. An individual employed for the purpose of 4 performing installation, maintenance, or other work on electric 5 utility lines.

6 Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to collective 7 bargaining procedures pursuant to chapter 20 initiated on or 8 after the effective date of this Act.

EXPLANATION

10The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with11the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

12 This bill designates individuals employed for the purpose of 13 performing installation, maintenance, or other work on electric 14 utility lines as public safety employees for the purposes of 15 collective bargaining pursuant to Code chapter 20, the public 16 employment relations Act. Code chapter 20 and Code chapter 17 400 include collective bargaining procedures specifically 18 applicable to public safety employees that are not applicable 19 to other public employees, including procedures relating to 20 the scope of collective bargaining negotiations, arbitration 21 procedures, and certain matters relating to city civil service 22 employment.

The bill applies to collective bargaining procedures pursuant to Code chapter 20 initiated on or after the effective date of the bill.
