SENATE FILE 2255

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A BILL FOR

1 An Act making appropriations to supplement federal moneys
2 received to fund 988 suicide and crisis lifeline services.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES —
2 988 SUICIDE AND CRISIS LIFELINE APPROPRIATION. There is
3 appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
4 department of health and human services for the fiscal year
5 beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025, the following
6 amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary to be used for the
7 purpose designated:

8 To supplement funds received from the federal substance
9 abuse and mental health services administration under the
10 cooperative agreements for states and territories to improve
11 local 988 capacity for the operations of organizations that
12 conduct 988 suicide and crisis lifeline telephone, text, or
13 internet services in this state:
14 \$ 3,719,940

15 Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated in this
16 section that remain unencumbered or unobligated at the close of
17 the fiscal year shall not revert but shall remain available for
18 expenditure for the purposes designated until the close of the
19 succeeding fiscal year.

20 EXPLANATION

21 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
22 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

23 This bill makes an appropriation of \$3,719,940 to the
24 department of health and human services for FY 2024-2025 for
25 the purpose of supplementing funds received from the federal
26 substance abuse and mental health services administration
27 under the cooperative agreements for states and territories to
28 improve local 988 capacity for the operations of organizations
29 that conduct 988 suicide and crisis lifeline telephone, text,
30 or internet services in Iowa. Moneys appropriated for this
31 purpose shall not revert to the general fund of the state, but
32 shall remain available for the purpose designated until the
33 close of FY 2025-2026.
