appropriated from the general fund of the state to the

beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025, the following
amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary to be used for the
purpose designated:

Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated in this section that remain unencumbered or unobligated at the close of the fiscal year shall not revert but shall remain available for section the purposes designated until the close of the succeeding fiscal year.

This bill makes an appropriation of \$3,719,940 to the department of health and human services for FY 2024-2025 for be purpose of supplementing funds received from the federal substance abuse and mental health services administration under the cooperative agreements for states and territories to ministration and territories to the operations of organizations that conduct 988 suicide and crisis lifeline telephone, text, or internet services in Iowa. Moneys appropriated for this purpose shall not revert to the general fund of the state, but shall remain available for the purpose designated until the close of FY 2025-2026.
