## A BILL FOR

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 124E.8, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code 1 2 2024, is amended to read as follows: The department shall issue a request for proposals 3 a. 4 accept applications to select and license by April 1, 2018, 5 up to five ten medical cannabidiol dispensaries to dispense 6 medical cannabidiol within this state consistent with the 7 provisions of this chapter. The department shall license new 8 medical cannabidiol dispensaries or relicense the existing 9 medical cannabidiol dispensaries by December 1 of each year. 10 A licensee may hold a maximum of three medical cannabidiol 11 dispensary licenses. 12 Sec. 2. Section 124E.8, subsection 2, Code 2024, is amended 13 by striking the subsection. 14 EXPLANATION 15 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. 16 17 This bill relates to the licensure of medical cannabidiol 18 dispensaries. The bill increases the maximum number of medical 19 cannabidiol dispensary licenses in the state from 5 to 10. 20 The bill allows a licensee to hold no more than three medical 21 cannabidiol dispensary licenses. 22 The bill strikes a provision in current law requiring a 23 medical cannabidiol dispensary to agree to begin supplying 24 medical cannabidiol by December 1, 2018.
