## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to close-clearance warning devices along
- 2 railroad tracks.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## S.F. 241

- 1 Section 1. Section 327F.13, subsection 2, Code 2023, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- The warning device shall be placed in a location which
- 4 that is a reasonable distance from the close-clearance area and
- 5 that provides adequate notice to a person riding the side of a
- 6 train so that the person may prepare for the close clearance.
- 7 Any signs posted shall not be a danger to other persons working
- 8 on the property.
- 9 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 12 Under current law, the owner of a railroad track is required
- 13 to place a warning device at a location where the close
- 14 clearance between the track and a building, machinery, trees,
- 15 brush, or other object is such that the building, machinery,
- 16 trees, brush, or other object physically impedes a person who
- 17 is lawfully riding the side of a train in the course of the
- 18 person's duties in service to a railroad company from clearing
- 19 the building, machinery, trees, brush, or other object. The
- 20 warning device must be placed in a location which provides
- 21 adequate notice to a person riding the side of a train so that
- 22 the person may prepare for the close clearance. This bill
- 23 requires the warning device to also be placed a reasonable
- 24 distance from the close-clearance area.
- 25 By operation of law, a violation of the bill is a schedule
- 26 "one" penalty, a fine of \$100 per violation.
