- 1 Section 1. Section 476.1A, subsection 2, Code 2023, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 2. However, sections 476.20, subsections 1 through 4,
- 4 476.21, 476.21A, 476.51, 476.56, 476.62, and 476.66 and
- 5 chapters 476A and 478, to the extent applicable, apply to such
- 6 electric utilities.
- 7 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 476.21A Rights-of-way notification —
- 8 rural electric cooperatives.
- 9 1. As used in this section:
- 10 a. "Fixture" means any equipment, structure, or other
- 11 improvement to land required to be constructed or installed by
- 12 a rural electric cooperative.
- 13 b. "Right-of-way" means a right-of-way or other interest in
- 14 real estate that is owned, operated, occupied, or managed on or
- 15 on behalf of a rural electric cooperative.
- 16 2. A rural electric cooperative installing a fixture in
- 17 a right-of-way shall provide written notice to be delivered
- 18 by certified mail to a landowner upon whose property the
- 19 right-of-way has been granted no later than thirty days before
- 20 installation and an additional written notification delivered
- 21 by certified mail prior to installation.
- 22 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 24 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 25 This bill relates to rural electric cooperative notification
- 26 requirements for installations in right-of-way structures.
- 27 The bill provides that rural electric cooperatives are
- 28 subject to the regulation authority of the board regarding
- 29 rights-of-way installation pursuant to Code section 476.21A.
- 30 The bill defines "fixture" and "right-of-way". The bill
- 31 provides that a rural electric cooperative installing a
- 32 fixture in a right-of-way shall provide written notice by
- 33 certified mail to the landowner no later than 30 days before
- 34 installation, as well as an additional written notice delivered
- 35 by certified mail prior to installation.
