A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to background investigations for certification
- 2 or recertification as a law enforcement officer.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **80B.17A Background investigation** 2 prior to certification or recertification.
- 3 1. For purposes of this section, "moral turpitude" is
- 4 defined as an act of baseness, vileness, or depravity in the
- 5 private and social duties which a person owes to another person
- 6 or to society in general, and includes conduct that is contrary
- 7 to justice, honesty, or good morals.
- 8 2. All law enforcement officers shall be certified through
- 9 the successful completion of training at an approved law
- 10 enforcement training facility. Prior to enrollment in a
- 11 certifying training program, all law enforcement officers shall
- 12 be of good moral character as determined through a thorough
- 13 background investigation and shall not have been convicted
- 14 of any felony or a crime or adjudication involving moral
- 15 turpitude, including but not limited to any of the following:
- 16 a. A misdemeanor crime of domestic violence as defined in
- 17 section 724.26, subsection 2, paragraph "c", or other offenses
- 18 of domestic violence.
- 19 b. An adjudication of delinquency based on conduct that
- 20 would constitute a felony if committed by an adult.
- 21 c. Any sex crime or crime listed in chapter 709.
- 22 d. Any crime committed as an adult that resulted in being
- 23 listed on the sex offender registry.
- 24 e. An adjudication of delinquency based on conduct that
- 25 would constitute a crime if committed by an adult that resulted
- 26 in being listed on the sex offender registry.
- 27 f. Any crime involving child abuse as defined in section
- 28 232.68, subsection 2, resulting in placement in the central
- 29 registry as a case of founded child abuse under section
- 30 232.71D.
- 31 3. All law enforcement officers seeking recertification
- 32 shall be subject to a background investigation as provided in
- 33 subsection 2.
- 34 EXPLANATION
- 35 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with

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the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
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      This bill relates to background investigations for
 3 certification or recertification as a law enforcement officer.
      The bill provides that prior to enrollment in a certifying
 5 training program, all law enforcement officers shall be of good
 6 moral character as determined through a thorough background
 7 investigation and shall not have been convicted of any felony
 8 or a crime or adjudication involving moral turpitude.
 9 defines "moral turpitude" as an act of baseness, vileness,
10 or depravity in the private and social duties which a person
11 owes to another person or to society in general, and includes
12 conduct that is contrary to justice, honesty, or good morals.

      The bill provides that a crime or adjudication involving
14 moral turpitude includes but is not limited to any of the
15 following: offenses of domestic violence; an adjudication of
16 delinquency based on conduct that would constitute a felony if
17 committed by an adult; any sex crime or crime listed in Code
18 chapter 709 (sexual abuse); any crime committed as an adult
19 that resulted in being listed on the sex offender registry;
20 an adjudication of delinquency based on conduct that would
21 constitute a crime if committed by an adult that resulted
22 in being listed on the sex offender registry; or any crime
23 involving child abuse.

      The bill provides that law enforcement officers seeking
25 recertification shall be subject to the same background
26 investigation.
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
