## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act concerning native brewery retail alcohol licenses.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 123.45, subsection 3, Code 2023, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 3. A person engaged in the wholesaling of beer or wine
- 4 may sell only disposable glassware, which is constructed of
- 5 paper, paper laminated, or plastic materials and designed
- 6 primarily for personal consumption on a one-time usage
- 7 basis, to retailers for use within the premises of licensed
- 8 establishments, for an amount which is greater than or equal
- 9 to an amount which represents the greater of either the amount
- 10 paid for the disposable glassware by the supplier or the amount
- 11 paid for the disposable glassware by the wholesaler. Also,
- 12 notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter or the fact
- 13 that a person is the holder of a class "A" beer permit, a native
- 14 brewery may be granted not more than two class "C" retail
- 15 alcohol licenses or not more than two special class "C" retail
- 16 alcohol licenses, both as defined in section 123.30, regardless
- 17 of whether that person is also a manufacturer of native
- 18 distilled spirits pursuant to a class "A" native distilled
- 19 spirits license or a manufacturer of native wine pursuant to a
- 20 class "A" wine permit.
- 21 Sec. 2. Section 123.130, subsection 2, Code 2023, is amended
- 22 to read as follows:
- 23 2. Pursuant to section 123.45, subsection 3, a native
- 24 brewery may be granted not more than two class "C" retail
- 25 alcohol licenses or not more than two special class "C" retail
- 26 alcohol licenses.
- 27 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 30 This bill provides that a native brewery may be granted up
- 31 to two special class "C" retail alcohol licenses. Current law
- 32 provides that a native brewery may only be granted up to two
- 33 class "C" retail alcohol licenses. A special class "C" retail
- 34 alcohol license allows the holder to purchase and sell wine and
- 35 beer while a class "C" retail alcohol license authorizes the

1 holder to purchase and sell alcoholic liquor, wine, and beer.
