## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the annual registration fee for certain
- vehicles owned by a volunteer fire fighter.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.109, Code 2023, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:
- NEW SUBSECTION. 4. a. Notwithstanding subsection 1 or any
- 4 other provision of law to the contrary, if a volunteer fire
- 5 fighter, as defined in section 85.61, meets the criteria set
- 6 forth in paragraph "b", the annual registration fee of one
- 7 vehicle displaying special registration plates issued pursuant
- 8 to section 321.34, subsection 10, and owned by the volunteer
- 9 fire fighter shall not exceed one hundred dollars. The annual
- 10 registration fee for no more than one vehicle per household is
- ll eligible for this limitation.
- 12 b. A volunteer fire fighter qualifies for the benefit
- 13 provided in paragraph "a" if the volunteer fire fighter meets
- 14 all of the following criteria:
- 15 (1) The person has served at least five years as a volunteer 16 fire fighter.
- 17 (2) The person's compensation is less than five thousand
- 18 dollars per year for service as a volunteer fire fighter.
- 19 (3) The person actively attends and participates in monthly
- 20 meetings, trainings, responses, and other duties as determined
- 21 by the public entity that the person serves.
- 22 (4) The person meets any additional requirements
- 23 established by the public entity that the person serves.
- 24 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 27 This bill limits the annual registration fee for a vehicle
- 28 displaying fire fighter special registration plates and owned
- 29 by an eligible volunteer fire fighter to \$100. The limited
- 30 annual registration fee applies to only one vehicle per
- 31 household. In order to qualify, the volunteer fire fighter
- 32 must have served for at least five years, receive compensation
- 33 of less than \$5,000 per year for service as a volunteer fire
- 34 fighter, actively attend and participate in monthly meetings,
- 35 trainings, responses, and other duties, and meet any additional

- 1 requirements established by the public entity that the
- 2 volunteer fire fighter serves.
