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A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to information collected from applicants for
- 2 education savings accounts and information reported by
- 3 the department of education, and including effective date
- 4 provisions.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. SHORT TITLE. This Act shall be known and may be
- 2 cited as the "Education Savings Account Transparency Act".
- 3 Sec. 2. Section 257.11B, subsection 3, as enacted by 2023
- 4 Iowa Acts, House File 68, section 7, is amended by adding the
- 5 following new paragraph:
- 6 NEW PARAGRAPH. Ob. As part of the application, the parent
- 7 or quardian shall provide information regarding household
- 8 income, household size, race and ethnicity of the pupil,
- 9 disability status, and whether the pupil has an individual
- 10 education program. The department of education or third-party
- 11 entity shall anonymize, summarize, and report such application
- 12 information annually to the general assembly by December 1
- 13 along with all of the following:
- 14 (1) Household income, household size, race and ethnicity,
- 15 disability status, and individual education plan status of the
- 16 pupil receiving the education savings account payment.
- 17 (2) Geographic and district of residence data for the pupil
- 18 receiving the education savings account payment.
- 19 (3) Education type and location for the pupil for the school
- 20 year preceding the year receiving the education savings account
- 21 payment.
- 22 (4) A categorized list of all reasons for recipient
- 23 withdrawals or expulsions from nonpublic schools occurring
- 24 prior to the conclusion of the nonpublic school's required
- 25 attendance period. Each nonpublic school shall report to the
- 26 department of education or third-party entity the reasons
- 27 for a pupil's withdrawal or expulsion within ten days of the
- 28 occurrence.
- 29 (5) Each nonpublic school's tuition and fees at each
- 30 grade level and such amounts for the preceding two school
- 31 years. Each nonpublic school shall annually report to the
- 32 department of education or third-party entity the tuition and
- 33 fee information described in this subparagraph.
- 34 (6) An annual summary of the qualified educational
- 35 expenditures by education savings account recipients. Within

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- 1 thirty days following the conclusion of the school year for
- 2 which an education savings account payment was received, the
- 3 parent or guardian shall file with the department of education
- 4 or third-party entity a statement that includes each nonpublic
- 5 school the pupil attended and an itemized list of all qualified
- 6 educational expenses paid for the child during the school year
- 7 using education savings account funds.
- 8 (7) All audits conducted by the department of education or
- 9 other state agency, or a third-party entity.
- 10 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 11 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 12 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 15 2023 Iowa Acts, House File 68, established the education
- 16 savings account program under Code section 257.11B to provide
- 17 education savings account payments to qualified pupils
- 18 attending nonpublic schools for the payment of qualified
- 19 educational expenses. This bill requires, as part of the
- 20 application, the parent or guardian to provide information
- 21 regarding household income, household size, race and ethnicity
- 22 of the pupil, disability status, and whether the pupil has an
- 23 individual education program. The department of education or
- 24 third-party entity administering the program shall anonymize,
- 25 summarize, and report such information annually to the general
- 26 assembly by December 1 along with other information required in
- 27 the bill relating to demographic and educational information
- 28 of education savings account recipients, reasons for student
- 29 withdrawals or expulsions during the school year, audits
- 30 conducted related to the program, and nonpublic school tuition
- 31 and fee information and qualified educational expenditure
- 32 information, as required to be reported in the bill.
- 33 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
