- 1 An Act repealing energy conservation requirements for new

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 103A.7, subsection 2, paragraph f, Code
2023, is amended by striking the paragraph.

3 Sec. 2. Section 103A.8, subsection 7, Code 2023, is amended4 by striking the subsection.

5 Sec. 3. Section 103A.10, subsections 4 and 5, Code 2023, are 6 amended by striking the subsections.

7 Sec. 4. Section 103A.10A, subsections 1 and 2, Code 2023, 8 are amended to read as follows:

9 1. All newly constructed buildings or structures subject to 10 the state building code, including any addition, but excluding 11 any renovation or repair of such a building or structure, owned 12 by the state or an agency of the state, except as provided in 13 subsection 2, shall be subject to a plan review and inspection 14 by the commissioner or an independent building inspector 15 appointed by the commissioner. Any renovation or repair 16 of such a building or structure shall be subject to a plan 17 review, except as provided in subsection 2. A fee shall be 18 assessed for the cost of plan review, and, if applicable, the 19 cost of inspection. The commissioner may inspect an existing 20 building that is undergoing renovation or remodeling to enforce 21 the energy conservation requirements established under this 22 chapter.

2. All newly constructed buildings, including any addition,
24 but excluding any renovation or repair of a building, owned by
25 the state board of regents shall be subject to a plan review
26 and inspection by the commissioner or the commissioner's
27 staff or assistant. A renovation of a building owned by the
28 state board of regents shall be subject to a plan review.
29 The commissioner may inspect an existing building that is
30 undergoing renovation or remodeling to enforce the energy
31 conservation requirements established under this chapter. The
32 commissioner and the state board of regents shall develop a
33 plan to implement this provision.

34 Sec. 5. Section 103A.19, subsection 1, Code 2023, is amended 35 to read as follows:

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1 1. The examination and approval or disapproval of plans 2 and specifications, the issuance and revocation of building 3 permits, licenses, certificates, and similar documents, the 4 inspection of buildings or structures, and the administration 5 and enforcement of building regulations shall be the 6 responsibility of the governmental subdivisions of the 7 state and shall be administered and enforced in the manner 8 prescribed by local law or ordinance. All provisions of 9 law relating to the administration and enforcement of local 10 building regulations in any governmental subdivision shall be 11 applicable to the administration and enforcement of the state 12 building code in the governmental subdivision. An application 13 made to a local building department or to a state agency for 14 permission to construct a building or structure pursuant to the 15 provisions of the state building code shall, in addition to 16 any other requirement, be signed by the owner or the owner's 17 authorized agent, and shall contain the address of the owner, 18 and a statement that the application is made for permission to 19 construct in accordance with the provisions of the code. The 20 application shall also specifically include a statement that 21 the construction will be in accordance with all applicable 22 energy conservation requirements.

23 Sec. 6. Section 103A.19, subsection 3, Code 2023, is amended 24 by striking the subsection.

25 Sec. 7. Section 103A.22, subsection 1, Code 2023, is amended 26 to read as follows:

1. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed as prohibiting any governmental subdivision from adopting or enacting any building regulations relating to any building or structure within its limits, but a governmental subdivision in which the state building code has been accepted and is applicable shall not have the power to supersede, void, or repeal or make more restrictive any of the provisions of this chapter or of the rules adopted by the commissioner. This subsection shall not apply to energy conservation requirements adopted by the

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1 commissioner and approved by the council pursuant to section 2 103A.8A or 103A.10. Sec. 8. Section 331.361, subsection 5, paragraph b, Code 3 4 2023, is amended by striking the paragraph. Sec. 9. Section 103A.8A, Code 2023, is repealed. 5 REPEAL. 6 EXPLANATION The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 7 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. 8 9 This bill repeals a requirement that the state building 10 code commissioner adopt energy conservation requirements for ll new single-family and two-family residential construction. 12 The bill strikes provisions applying the energy conservation 13 requirements to other construction in the state and requiring 14 compliance with energy conservation requirements.

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
