## A BILL FOR

- An Act relating to requirements for the split and consolidation
  of parcels.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 354.2, Code 2023, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsections:

3 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 4A. "*Consolidation"* means merging two or 4 more tracts or parcels of land into one parcel of land.

5 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 16A. "*Split*" means dividing a parcel of 6 land into two or more parcels of land when a plat of survey or 7 acquisition plat is not required.

8 Sec. 2. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 354.28 Split or consolidation not 9 requiring plat of survey or acquisition plat.

10 The county assessor or county auditor, as applicable, 11 shall not approve a split or consolidation for which a plat 12 of survey or acquisition plat is not required, unless each 13 parcel involved in the split or consolidation is not within the 14 redemption period under chapter 447 or the period specified 15 in section 448.12 following a tax sale under chapter 446 and 16 is free from unpaid property taxes, special assessments, and 17 drainage assessments for which a waiver or abatement has not 18 been approved.

This bill provides that a county assessor or county auditor, as applicable, shall not approve a split or consolidation, as each is defined in the bill, for which a plat of survey or carcuisition plat is not required, unless each parcel involved in the split or consolidation is not within the redemption period under Code chapter 447 or the period specified in Code section 448.12 following a tax sale and is free from unpaid property taxes, special assessments, and drainage assessments for which a waiver or abatement has not been approved.
