## A BILL FOR

- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{1}}$  An Act relating to the registration of construction
- 2 contractors.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 91C.1, subsection 1, Code 2023, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 1. As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise
- 4 requires, "contractor" means a person who engages in the
- 5 business of construction, as the term "construction" is defined
- 6 in the Iowa administrative code for purposes of the Iowa
- 7 employment security law. However, a person who earns less than
- 8 two thousand dollars annually or who performs work or has work
- 9 performed on the person's own property is not a contractor for
- 10 purposes of this chapter. "Contractor" includes a labor broker
- ll or recruiter who brings one or more workers to a construction
- 12 job site in this state. The state, its boards, commissions,
- 13 agencies, departments, and its political subdivisions including
- 14 school districts and other special purpose districts, are not
- 15 contractors for purposes of this chapter.
- 16 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 19 This bill provides that a contractor, for purposes of
- 20 Code chapter 91C relating to registration of construction
- 21 contractors, includes a labor broker or recruiter who brings
- 22 one or more workers to a construction job site in Iowa.
- 23 Code chapter 91C provides for administrative penalties of
- 24 not more than \$500 in the case of a first violation and not more
- 25 than \$5,000 for each subsequent violation.
