## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act creating the community law enforcement enhancement fund
- 2 and providing an appropriation.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **80.49 Community law enforcement** 2 enhancement fund.
- A community law enforcement enhancement fund is
- 4 established in the state treasury under the control of the
- 5 department. The fund shall consist of moneys appropriated to
- 6 the fund for the purposes specified in subsection 2.
- 7 2. Moneys appropriated to the fund shall be used for grants
- 8 to municipal police departments and county sheriff departments.
- 9 Grants may be awarded for the following purposes:
- 10 a. Peace officer body cameras. For the purchase of
- 11 equipment, training, the establishment of information storage
- 12 and retrieval procedures and facilities, and other expenses
- 13 properly related to initiating a program for peace officers to
- 14 wear and operate body cameras while on duty in the community.
- 15 b. Community mental health support and services.
- 16 (1) For recruiting, training, and paying a portion of the
- 17 first-year salary and benefits of a community mental health
- 18 advocate position within a municipal police department or
- 19 county sheriff department. The duties of a community mental
- 20 health advocate shall include but are not limited to the
- 21 following:
- 22 (a) Provide access to mental health services that may be
- 23 necessary after a person's contact with law enforcement.
- 24 (b) Act as a liaison between a local law enforcement agency
- 25 and mental health services providers and agencies.
- 26 (c) Review departmental calls for mental health services to
- 27 identify the mental health needs of consumers.
- 28 (d) Assist mental health consumers with identifying and
- 29 obtaining services.
- 30 (e) Assist mental health services providers in
- 31 understanding consumer needs in the community.
- 32 (f) Coordinate and assist with law enforcement actions
- 33 requiring possible mental health services.
- 34 (g) Assist in developing, coordinating, and implementing
- 35 mental health training.

- 1 (2) For expenses properly related to initiating and
- 2 providing services related to the duties specified in
- 3 subparagraph (1) incurred through collaboration between a
- 4 municipal police department or county sheriff department and
- 5 one or more local mental health organizations or social service
- 6 organizations.
- A municipal police department or county sheriff
- 8 department may make separate applications for each of the two
- 9 purposes specified in subsection 2.
- 10 4. Grant awards may be made for up to fifty thousand dollars 11 per grant awarded.
- 12 5. The department shall allocate at least thirty percent
- 13 of available funds for grants for each of the two purposes
- 14 specified in subsection 2, provided that adequate qualified
- 15 applications are received in each category. The department
- 16 shall distribute funds as equitably as possible to achieve a
- 17 balanced distribution of funds geographically within the state
- 18 and among large and small communities.
- 19 6. Notwithstanding section 8.33, any balance in the fund on
- 20 June 30 of any fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund
- 21 of the state but shall remain available for expenditure for the
- 22 purposes designated for subsequent fiscal years.
- 7. The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A
- 24 necessary for the administration of this section.
- 25 8. This section is repealed January 1, 2030.
- 26 Sec. 2. COMMUNITY LAW ENFORCEMENT ENHANCEMENT FUND -
- 27 APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated from the general fund of
- 28 the state to the department of public safety for deposit into
- 29 the community law enforcement enhancement fund established in
- 30 section 80.49 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and
- 31 ending June 30, 2024, the following amount, or so much thereof
- 32 as is necessary, to be used for the purposes of the fund:
- \$ 5,000,000
- 34 EXPLANATION
- 35 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with

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the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
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      This bill creates the community law enforcement enhancement
 3 fund (fund) established in the state treasury under the
 4 control of the department of public safety and provides an
 5 appropriation.
      The bill provides that moneys appropriated to the fund
 7 shall be used for grants to municipal police departments and
 8 county sheriff departments for the following purposes:
 9 the purchase of equipment, training, the establishment of
10 information storage and retrieval procedures and facilities,
11 and other expenses properly related to initiating a program for
12 peace officers to wear and operate body cameras while on duty
13 in the community; and for recruiting, training, and paying a
14 portion of the first-year salary and benefits of a community
15 mental health advocate position within a municipal police
16 department or a county sheriff department.
                                               The bill specifies
17 the duties of a community mental health advocate which include
18 but are not limited to the following: providing access to
19 mental health services that may be necessary after a person's
20 contact with law enforcement; acting as a liaison between
21 a local law enforcement agency and mental health services
22 providers and agencies; reviewing departmental calls for
23 mental health services to identify the mental health needs of
24 consumers; assisting mental health consumers with identifying
25 and obtaining services; assisting mental health services
26 providers in understanding consumer needs in the community;
27 coordinating and assisting with law enforcement actions
28 requiring possible mental health services; and assisting in
29 developing, coordinating, and implementing mental health
30 training.
      The bill provides that a grant may be awarded for expenses
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32 properly related to initiating and providing services
33 related to the duties specified in the bill incurred through
34 collaboration between a municipal police department or
35 county sheriff department and one or more local mental health
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- 1 organizations or social service organizations.
- 2 The bill provides that grant awards may be made for up to
- 3 \$50,000 per grant awarded, and a municipal police department or
- 4 county sheriff department may make separate applications for
- 5 each of the two purposes of the fund. The department of public
- 6 safety shall allocate at least 30 percent of available funds
- 7 to grants for each of the two purposes of the fund, and shall
- 8 distribute funds as equitably as possible to achieve a balanced
- 9 distribution of funds geographically within the state and among
- 10 large and small communities. Any balance in the fund on June
- 11 30 of any fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund of
- 12 the state.
- 13 The department is directed to adopt rules pursuant to Code
- 14 chapter 17A necessary for the administration of the bill.
- 15 The bill is repealed on January 1, 2030.
- 16 The bill makes an appropriation of \$5 million from the
- 17 general fund of the state to the department of public safety
- 18 for deposit into the fund established in the bill for the
- 19 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.
