A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to funding amounts for the statewide preschool
- 2 program and including applicability provisions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 256C.5, subsection 1, paragraph c, Code 2 2023, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 c. "Preschool budget enrollment" means:
- 4 (1) For school districts providing ten or more hours, but
- 5 less than fifteen hours, per week of instruction, the figure
- 6 that is equal to fifty percent of the actual enrollment of
- 7 eligible students in the preschool programming provided by
- 8 a school district approved to participate in the preschool
- 9 program on October 1 of the base year, or the first Monday in
- 10 October if October 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday.
- 11 (2) For school districts providing fifteen or more hours,
- 12 but less than twenty hours, per week of instruction, the figure
- 13 that is equal to seventy percent of the actual enrollment of
- 14 eligible students in the preschool programming provided by
- 15 a school district approved to participate in the preschool
- 16 program on October 1 of the base year, or the first Monday in
- 17 October if October 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday.
- 18 (3) For school districts providing twenty or more hours,
- 19 but less than twenty-five hours, per week of instruction, the
- 20 figure that is equal to eighty percent of the actual enrollment
- 21 of eligible students in the preschool programming provided by
- 22 a school district approved to participate in the preschool
- 23 program on October 1 of the base year, or the first Monday in
- 24 October if October 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday.
- 25 (4) For school districts providing twenty-five or more
- 26 hours, but less than thirty hours, per week of instruction, the
- 27 figure that is equal to ninety percent of the actual enrollment
- 28 of eligible students in the preschool programming provided by
- 29 a school district approved to participate in the preschool
- 30 program on October 1 of the base year, or the first Monday in
- 31 October if October 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday.
- (5) For school districts providing thirty or more hours per
- 33 week of instruction, the figure that is equal to the actual
- 34 enrollment of eligible students in the preschool programming
- 35 provided by a school district approved to participate in the

1 preschool program on October 1 of the base year, or the first 2 Monday in October if October 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday. Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to school budget 3 4 years beginning on or after July 1, 2024. 5 **EXPLANATION** The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 6 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. 7 Under Code chapter 256C, preschool foundation aid is 9 calculated by multiplying the school district's preschool 10 budget enrollment by the regular program state cost per 11 pupil for the budget year. "Preschool budget enrollment" is 12 defined as the figure that is equal to 50 percent of the actual 13 enrollment of eligible students in the preschool programming 14 provided by a school district approved to participate in the 15 preschool program on October 1 of the base year. This bill modifies the percentage used to calculate 16 17 "preschool budget enrollment" based on the number of hours of 18 instruction provided. For school districts providing 10 or 19 more hours, but less than 15 hours, per week of instruction, 20 the percentage remains at 50 percent. For school districts 21 providing 15 or more hours, but less than 20 hours, per week 22 of instruction, the percentage is 70 percent. For school 23 districts providing 20 or more hours, but less than 25 hours, 24 per week of instruction, the percentage is 80 percent. For 25 school districts providing 25 or more hours, but less than 30 26 hours, per week of instruction, the percentage is 90 percent. 27 For school districts providing 30 or more hours per week of

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The bill applies to school budget years beginning on or after

28 instruction, the percentage is 100 percent.
