## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act establishing the cybersecurity simulation training
- 2 center at the Iowa state university of science and
- 3 technology, and making appropriations.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **266.50 Cybersecurity simulation** 2 training center.
- The cybersecurity simulation training center is
- 4 established in the center for cybersecurity innovation
- 5 and outreach at the Iowa state university of science and
- 6 technology.
- 7 2. The cybersecurity simulation training center shall
- 8 conduct and sponsor research and activities that enable persons
- 9 to develop strategies to counter cybersecurity threats and
- 10 mitigate the damage resulting from a cybersecurity attack.
- 11 3. The cybersecurity simulation training center shall be
- 12 available to businesses, state agencies, political subdivisions
- 13 of the state, students, and educators, and shall support all
- 14 of the following:
- 15 a. Cybersecurity training exercises.
- 16 b. Case studies.
- 17 c. Student events and competitions.
- 18 d. Training exercises for educators.
- 19 e. Cybersecurity workforce development.
- 20 Sec. 2. STATE BOARD OF REGENTS CYBERSECURITY SIMULATION
- 21 TRAINING CENTER APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated from
- 22 the general fund of the state to the state board of regents for
- 23 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30,
- 24 2024, the following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary,
- 25 to be used for the purposes designated:
- 26 For purposes of the cybersecurity simulation training
- 27 center at the Iowa state university of science and technology
- 28 established pursuant to section 266.50, as enacted in this Act:
- 29 ..... \$ 2,500,000
- 30 Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys appropriated in this
- 31 section that remain unencumbered or unobligated at the close of
- 32 the fiscal year shall not revert but shall remain available for
- 33 expenditure for the purposes designated until the close of the
- 34 fiscal year that begins July 1, 2025.
- 35 Sec. 3. CODE EDITOR DIRECTIVE. The Code editor may

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- 1 designate section 266.50, as enacted in this Act, as a new
- 2 subchapter within chapter 266, entitled "cybersecurity
- 3 simulation training center".
- 4 EXPLANATION
- 5 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 6 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 7 This bill establishes the cybersecurity simulation training
- 8 center at the Iowa state university of science and technology.
- 9 The bill requires the center to conduct and sponsor research
- 10 and activities that enable persons to develop strategies to
- 11 counter cybersecurity threats and mitigate the damage resulting
- 12 from a cybersecurity attack. The bill provides that the center
- 13 shall be available to businesses, state agencies, political
- 14 subdivisions of the state, students, and educators, and shall
- 15 support cybersecurity training exercises, case studies, student
- 16 events and competitions, training exercises for educators, and
- 17 cybersecurity workforce development.
- 18 The bill appropriates \$2.5 million from the general fund of
- 19 the state to the state board of regents for FY 2023-2024 for
- 20 purposes of the center. The bill provides that if these moneys
- 21 remain unencumbered or unobligated at the close the fiscal
- 22 year, the moneys shall not revert but shall remain available
- 23 for expenditure until the close of FY 2025-2026.
