- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.F. 405

- 1 Section 1. Section 614.1, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code
- 2 2023, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 Actions may be brought within the times limited as follows,
- 4 respectively, after their causes accrue, and not afterwards,
- 5 except as provided in section 614.1A or when otherwise
- 6 specially declared:
- 7 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 614.1A Toll COVID-19.
- 8 Any statute of limitations, statute of repose, or similar
- 9 deadline for commencing an action in district court that would
- 10 have otherwise expired between March 17, 2020, and December 31,
- 11 2020, is tolled by seventy-six days.
- 12 Sec. 3. REPEAL. This Act is repealed July 1, 2032.
- 13 Sec. 4. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY. This Act applies
- 14 retroactively to March 17, 2020.
- 15 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 18 This bill relates to statutes of limitations tolled by the
- 19 Iowa supreme court. The bill codifies Iowa supreme court
- 20 emergency orders which tolled the statute of limitations for
- 21 commencing civil and criminal actions in the district court.
- 22 The limitation periods are extended by 76 days for actions
- 23 that would have otherwise expired between March 17, 2020, and
- 24 December 31, 2020.
- 25 The bill is repealed July 1, 2032, and applies retroactively
- 26 to March 17, 2020.
