A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to eligibility for education savings accounts
- 2 and including effective date and retroactive applicability
- 3 provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 257.11B, subsection 2, paragraph a, as
- 2 enacted by 2023 Iowa Acts, House File 68, section 7, is amended
- 3 by striking the paragraph and inserting in lieu thereof the
- 4 following:
- 5 a. (1) For the school budget year beginning July 1, 2023,
- 6 resident pupils who are eligible to enroll in kindergarten
- 7 through grade twelve and who attend a nonpublic school for that
- 8 school budget year shall be eligible to receive an education
- 9 savings account payment if the pupil's household has an annual
- 10 income less than or equal to three hundred percent of the most
- 11 recently revised poverty income guidelines published by the
- 12 United States department of health and human services.
- 13 (2) For school budget years beginning on or after July
- 14 1, 2024, resident pupils who are eligible to enroll in
- 15 kindergarten through grade twelve and who attend a nonpublic
- 16 school for that school budget year shall be eligible to receive
- 17 an education savings account payment if the pupil's household
- 18 has an annual income less than or equal to four hundred
- 19 percent of the most recently revised poverty income guidelines
- 20 published by the United States department of health and human
- 21 services.
- 22 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 23 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 24 Sec. 3. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY. This Act applies
- 25 retroactively to January 24, 2023.
- 26 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 29 2023 Iowa Acts, House File 68, provides education savings
- 30 account payments for eligible pupils for the payment of
- 31 qualified educational expenses. This bill strikes the
- 32 eligibility provision from that Act for the education savings
- 33 account payments and instead provides that for the school
- 34 budget year beginning July 1, 2023, resident pupils who are
- 35 eligible to enroll in kindergarten through grade 12 and who

- 1 attend a nonpublic school for that school budget year shall be
- 2 eligible to receive an education savings account payment if
- 3 the pupil's household has an annual income less than or equal
- 4 to 300 percent of the most recently revised poverty income
- 5 guidelines published by the United States department of health
- 6 and human services. Then for the school budget years beginning
- 7 on or after July 1, 2024, resident pupils who are eligible
- 8 to enroll in kindergarten through grade 12 and who attend a
- 9 nonpublic school for that school budget year shall be eligible
- 10 to receive an education savings account payment if the pupil's
- 11 household has an annual income less than or equal to 400
- 12 percent of the most recently revised poverty income guidelines
- 13 published by the United States department of health and human
- 14 services.
- The bill takes effect upon enactment and applies
- 16 retroactively to January 24, 2023.
