A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to tenure systems, including modifying
- 2 provisions related to tenure systems adopted by institutions
- 3 of higher education governed by the state board of regents
- 4 and implementing standards for community college tenure
- 5 systems.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 260C.36, Code 2023, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 5. The board of directors of a community
- 4 college shall not establish a tenure system for any employee
- 5 of the community college unless the tenure system requires
- 6 the employee to participate in a post-tenure review process
- 7 at least once every three years after the award of tenure to
- 8 assess the employee's performance.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 262.9, Code 2023, is amended by adding the
- 10 following new subsection:
- 11 NEW SUBSECTION. 39. Prohibit, at each institution of
- 12 higher education governed by the state board of regents, the
- 13 establishment or continuation of a tenure system for any
- 14 employee of the institution unless the tenure system requires
- 15 the employee to participate in a post-tenure review process
- 16 at least once every three years after the award of tenure to
- 17 assess the employee's performance.
- 18 Sec. 3. Section 262.12, Code 2023, is amended to read as
- 19 follows:
- 20 262.12 Committees and administrative offices under board.
- 21 The board of regents shall also have and exercise all
- 22 the powers necessary and convenient for the effective
- 23 administration of its office and of the institutions under
- 24 its control, and to this end may create such committees,
- 25 offices and agencies from its own members or others, and employ
- 26 persons to staff the same, fix their compensation and, subject
- 27 to section 262.9, subsection 39, their tenure, and delegate
- 28 thereto, or to the administrative officers and faculty of the
- 29 institutions under its control, such part of the authority and
- 30 duties vested by statute in the board, and shall formulate and
- 31 establish such rules, outline such policies and prescribe such
- 32 procedures therefor, all as may be desired or determined by the
- 33 board as recorded in their minutes.
- 34 Sec. 4. Section 262.82, subsection 2, Code 2023, is amended
- 35 to read as follows:

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- 2. The board of regents shall also establish a program
 2 to create faculty opportunities for women educators at the
 3 universities under the board's control. The program shall
 4 include but is not limited to the creation of faculty positions
 5 in targeted shortage areas. The Subject to section 262.9,
 6 subsection 39, the board of regents shall also develop
 7 and implement, in consultation with appropriate faculty
 8 representatives, tenure, promotion, and hiring policies that
 9 recognize the unique needs of faculty members who are principal
 10 caregivers to dependents.
- 11 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- This bill relates to tenure systems, including modifying provisions related to tenure systems adopted by institutions of higher education governed by the state board of regents and implementing standards to govern community college tenure systems if such systems are adopted by community colleges.

 The bill prohibits the board of directors of a community college and institutions of higher education governed by the state board of regents from establishing or continuing a tenure system for any employee of the community college or institution unless the tenure system requires the employee to participate in a post-tenure review process at least once every three years after the award of tenure to assess the employee's performance.

 The bill makes conforming changes.
