- 1 An Act relating to information made available to the auditor of
- 2 state.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.F. 478

- 1 Section 1. Section 11.41, subsection 3, Code 2023, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- If the information, records, instrumentalities, and
 properties sought by the auditor of state are required by law
- 5 to be kept confidential, the auditor of state shall have access
- 6 to the information, records, instrumentalities, and properties,
- 7 but shall maintain the confidentiality of all such information
- 8 and is subject to the same penalties as the lawful custodian
- 9 of the information for dissemination of the information.
- 10 However, the auditor of state shall not have access to the
- 11 income tax returns of individuals, or to an individual's name
- 12 or residential address from a reportable disease report under
- 13 section 139A.3, medical records, academic information, or other
- 14 similar information that an individual would reasonably expect
- 15 to be kept private.
- 16 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 19 This bill relates to information that the auditor of
- 20 state shall have access to during the course of an audit or
- 21 examination. The bill prohibits the auditor of state from
- 22 having access to an individual's medical records, academic
- 23 information, or other similar information that an individual
- 24 would reasonably expect to be kept private.
