- 1 An Act repealing energy conservation requirements for new

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 103A.8A, Code 2023, is amended to read 2 as follows:

3 103A.8A Energy conservation requirements — rulemaking 4 requirements.

The state building code commissioner shall adopt as 5 1. 6 a part of the state building code a requirement that new 7 single-family or two-family residential construction shall 8 comply with energy conservation requirements. The requirements 9 adopted by the commissioner shall be based upon a nationally 10 recognized standard or code for energy conservation. The ll requirements shall only apply to single-family or two-family 12 residential construction commenced after the adoption of the 13 requirements. Notwithstanding any other provision of this 14 chapter to the contrary, the energy conservation requirements 15 adopted by the commissioner and approved by the council 16 shall apply to new single-family or two-family residential 17 construction commenced on or after July 1, 2008, and shall 18 supersede and replace any minimum requirements for energy 19 conservation adopted or enacted by a governmental subdivision 20 prior to that date applicable to such construction except 21 that a governmental subdivision may enact energy conservation 22 requirements that are less restrictive than the state building The state building code commissioner may provide 23 code. 24 training to builders, contractors, and other interested persons 25 on the adopted energy conservation requirements. 26 2. The state building code commissioner shall not amend 27 or rescind 661 IAC 303.2 or 661 IAC 303.3, as they existed 28 on January 1, 2023, except as required by the adoption of a 29 statute by the general assembly. The state building code 30 commissioner may submit a proposal to the general assembly for 31 the amendment or rescission of 661 IAC 303.2 or 661 IAC 303.3, 32 which shall include an estimate of all costs associated with 33 the amendment or rescission.

34 Sec. 2. Section 103A.10, subsection 4, paragraph a, Code 35 2023, is amended to read as follows:

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1 a. Provisions of the state building code establishing 2 thermal efficiency energy conservation standards shall be 3 applicable to all construction in the state which will contain 4 enclosed space that is heated or cooled, except where a 5 governmental subdivision has enacted energy conservation 6 requirements that are less restrictive than the state 7 building code. The commissioner shall provide appropriate 8 exceptions for construction where the application of an energy 9 conservation requirement adopted pursuant to this chapter would 10 be impractical. 11 Sec. 3. Section 103A.10, subsection 5, Code 2023, is amended 12 to read as follows: 13 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter to 14 the contrary, the energy conservation requirements adopted 15 by the commissioner and approved by the council shall apply 16 to all new construction commenced on or after July 1, 2008, 17 and shall supersede and replace any minimum requirements for 18 energy conservation adopted or enacted by the except that a 19 governmental subdivision prior to that date and applicable to 20 such construction may enact energy conservation requirements 21 that are less restrictive than the state building code. 22 Sec. 4. Section 103A.22, subsection 1, Code 2023, is amended 23 to read as follows: 24 1. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed as prohibiting 25 any governmental subdivision from adopting or enacting any 26 building regulations relating to any building or structure 27 within its limits, but a governmental subdivision in which 28 the state building code has been accepted and is applicable 29 shall not have the power to supersede, void, or repeal or 30 make more restrictive any of the provisions of this chapter 31 or of the rules adopted by the commissioner. This subsection 32 shall not apply to, except that a governmental subdivision 33 may adopt or enact energy conservation requirements that are 34 less restrictive than energy conservation requirements adopted 35 by the commissioner and approved by the council pursuant to
