## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to health care employment agency reporting
- 2 requirements.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 135Q.2, subsection 4, Code 2023, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 4. A health care employment agency shall submit a report to 4 the department on a quarterly basis for each health care entity 5 participating in Medicare or Medicaid with whom the agency
- 6 contracts that includes all of the following by provider type:
- 7 <u>a. A a</u> detailed list of the average amount charged to the 8 health care entity for each individual agency worker category.
- 9 b. A detailed list of the average amount paid by the agency
  10 to agency workers in each individual agency worker category.
- 11 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 14 This bill relates to the reporting requirements for a health 15 care employment agency.
- 16 Under current law, a health care employment agency is
- 17 required to submit a report to the department of inspections
- 18 and appeals on a quarterly basis for each health care entity
- 19 participating in Medicare or Medicaid with whom the agency
- 20 contracts that includes both a detailed list of the average
- 21 amount charged to the health care entity for each individual
- 22 agency worker category and a detailed list of the average
- 23 amount paid by the agency to agency workers in each individual
- 24 agency worker category. The bill eliminates the required
- 25 reporting of the detailed list of the average amount paid by
- 26 the agency to agency workers in each individual agency worker
- 27 category.
