A BILL FOR

An Act relating to certain amounts of school district funding
 for programs for at-risk students, secondary students who
 attend alternative programs or alternative schools, or
 returning dropouts and dropout prevention, and including
 effective date provisions.
 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 257.41, subsection 3, Code 2023, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 3. Limitation.

4 <u>a.</u> For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, and each 5 succeeding fiscal year <u>beginning before July 1, 2023</u>, the ratio 6 of the amount of the modified supplemental amount established 7 by the department of management compared to the school 8 district's total regular program district cost shall not exceed 9 two and one-half percent. However, if the school district's 10 highest such ratio so determined for any fiscal year beginning 11 on or after July 1, 2009, but before July 1, 2013, exceeded two 12 and one-half percent, the ratio may exceed two and one-half 13 percent but shall not exceed the highest such ratio established 14 during that period.

b. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, the ratio of
the amount of the modified supplemental amount established by
the department of management compared to the school district's
total regular program district cost shall not exceed three
percent. However, if the school district's highest such ratio
so determined for any fiscal year beginning on or after July
1, 2009, but before July 1, 2013, exceeded three percent, the
ratio may exceed three percent but shall not exceed the highest
such ratio established during that period.

24 c. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, the ratio of 25 the amount of the modified supplemental amount established by 26 the department of management compared to the school district's 27 total regular program district cost shall not exceed three and 28 one-half percent. However, if the school district's highest 29 such ratio so determined for any fiscal year beginning on or 30 after July 1, 2009, but before July 1, 2013, exceeded three 31 and one-half percent, the ratio may exceed three and one-half 32 percent but shall not exceed the highest such ratio established 33 during that period.

34 <u>d.</u> For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, the ratio of 35 the amount of the modified supplemental amount established by

For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2027, and each 19 succeeding fiscal year, the ratio of the amount of the modified 20 supplemental amount established by the department of management 21 compared to the school district's total regular program 22 district cost shall not exceed five percent. 23 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate 24 importance, takes effect upon enactment. 25 EXPLANATION 26 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 27 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. As part of the budget for a school district's program for 28 29 at-risk students, secondary students who attend alternative 30 programs and alternative schools, or returning dropouts and 31 dropout prevention, the school board may request to use a 32 modified supplemental amount. However, current law provides 33 that the ratio of the amount of the modified supplemental 34 amount compared to the school district's total regular program 35 district cost shall not exceed 2.5 percent or the school

1 district's highest ratio for any fiscal year beginning on or 2 after July 1, 2009, but before July 1, 2013, whichever is 3 greater.

4 This bill modifies the maximum modified supplemental amount 5 calculation for fiscal years beginning on or after July 1, 6 2023, but before July 1, 2027, by increasing the 2.5 percent 7 ratio figure by 0.5 percent each fiscal year until the fiscal 8 year beginning July 1, 2027, and each fiscal year thereafter, 9 when the maximum ratio percentage is set at 5 percent for all 10 school districts.
