As a condition of licensure under this chapter, a hospital 4 shall not institute a policy that limits a patient's ability to 5 receive visitors designated by the patient during an inpatient 6 hospital stay, regardless of the patient's diagnosis. However, 7 a hospital may impose infection control protocols otherwise 8 required that are related to the physical presence of such 9 designated visitors.

10 Sec. 2. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 135C.35A Resident visitation policies
11 — nursing facilities.

12 As a condition of licensure under this chapter, a nursing 13 facility shall not institute a policy that limits a resident's 14 ability to receive visitors designated by the resident, 15 regardless of the resident's diagnosis. However, a nursing 16 facility may impose infection control protocols otherwise 17 required that are related to the physical presence of such 18 designated visitors.

This bill requires that as a condition of licensure for a hospital or nursing facility, a hospital or nursing facility shall not institute a policy that limits a patient's or resident's ability to receive visitors designated by the patient during an inpatient hospital stay or designated by the resident, regardless of the patient's or resident's diagnosis. However, a hospital or nursing facility may impose infection control protocols otherwise required that are related to the physical presence of such designated visitors.

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
