- 1 Section 1. MEDICAID EXTENDED POSTPARTUM COVERAGE
- 2 OPTION. The department of health and human services shall
- 3 submit a Medicaid state plan amendment to the centers for
- 4 Medicare and Medicaid services of the United States department
- 5 of health and human services for approval of the option
- 6 to provide twelve months of continuous postpartum coverage
- 7 under the Medicaid program to pregnant women enrolled in the
- 8 Medicaid program in accordance with sections 9812 and 9822
- 9 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Pub. L. No.
- 10 117-2, as amended by section 5113 of the federal Consolidated
- 11 Appropriations Act of 2023.
- 12 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 13 importance, takes effect upon enactment.

- 17 Under current federal law, pregnant Medicaid beneficiaries
- 18 are eligible for at least pregnancy-related services through
- 19 the end of the month in which the 60-day period beginning on
- 20 the last day of the pregnancy ends.
- 21 Provisions of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021
- 22 (H.R. 1319) provide the option to states to submit a state
- 23 plan amendment to provide postpartum Medicaid coverage for 12
- 24 months after the end of a pregnancy for a five-year period. A
- 25 provision under the federal Consolidated Appropriations Act of
- 26 2023 removed the five-year limitation.
- 27 This bill requires the department of health and human
- 28 services (HHS) to submit a Medicaid state plan amendment to the
- 29 centers for Medicare and Medicaid services of the United States
- 30 department of health and human services for approval of the new
- 31 option to provide 12 months of continuous postpartum coverage
- 32 under the Medicaid program to pregnant women enrolled in the
- 33 Medicaid program.
- 34 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
