## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution
- of the State of Iowa limiting years of service for members
- of the general assembly.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## S.J.R. 3

- 1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of 2 the State of Iowa is proposed:
- 3 l. Section 3 of Article III of the Constitution of the State
- 4 of Iowa is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:
- 5 Sec. 3. Representatives. The members of the house of
- 6 representatives shall be chosen every second year, by the
- 7 qualified electors of their respective districts, and their
- 8 term of office shall commence on the first day of January next
- 9 after their election, and continue two years, and until their
- 10 successors are elected and qualified. A person shall not be
- 11 elected for a term as representative if the term would result
- 12 in the person serving more than a total of twenty years as
- 13 a member of the general assembly. This limitation on years
- 14 of service applies to terms of office beginning on or after
- 15 January 1, 2029.
- 2. Section 5 of Article III of the Constitution of the State
- 17 of Iowa is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:
- 18 Sec. 5. Senators qualifications. Senators shall be
- 19 chosen for the term of four years, at the same time and place as
- 20 representatives; they shall be twenty-five years of age, and
- 21 possess the qualifications of representatives as to residence
- 22 and citizenship. A person shall not be elected for a term
- 23 as senator if the term would result in the person serving
- 24 more than a total of twenty years as a member of the general
- 25 assembly. This limitation on years of service applies to terms
- 26 of office beginning on or after January 1, 2029.
- 27 Sec. 2. REFERRAL AND PUBLICATION. The foregoing proposed
- 28 amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa is referred
- 29 to the general assembly to be chosen at the next general
- 30 election for members of the general assembly, and shall be
- 31 published as provided by law for three months previous to the
- 32 date of that election.
- 33 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

## S.J.R. 3

- 1 This joint resolution proposes an amendment to the
- 2 Constitution of the State of Iowa limiting years of service
- 3 for persons elected to the office of representative or senator
- 4 in the general assembly. The amendment provides that a member
- 5 of the house of representatives or the senate shall not serve
- 6 more than 20 years as a member of the general assembly. The
- 7 amendment applies to terms of office beginning on or after
- 8 January 1, 2029.
- 9 The resolution, if adopted, would be referred to the next
- 10 general assembly for adoption before being submitted to the
- 11 electorate for ratification.
