A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the application for a certificate of
- 2 franchise authority applicable to the provision of video
- 3 services and including effective date provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 477A.1, subsection 16, Code 2023, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 16. "Video service" means video programming services
- 4 provided by a competitive video service provider through
- 5 wireline facilities located at least in part in the public
- 6 right-of-way without regard to delivery technology, including
- 7 internet protocol technology. "Video service" does not include
- 8 any video of the following:
- 9 a. Video programming provided by a provider of commercial
- 10 mobile service as defined in 47 U.S.C. §332, or cable.
- 11 b. Cable service provided by an incumbent cable provider or
- 12 a competitive cable service provider or any.
- 13 c. Video programming provided by a provider of
- 14 direct-to-home satellite services as defined in 47 U.S.C.
- 15 $\S 303(v)$.
- 16 d. Any video programming provided solely as part of, and
- 17 accessed via, a service that enables users to access content,
- 18 information, electronic mail, or other services offered over
- 19 the public internet, including digital audio-visual works.
- 20 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 21 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 22 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 24 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 25 This bill modifies the definition of "video service"
- 26 applicable to a competitive video service provider applying for
- 27 a certificate of franchise authority to provide cable and video
- 28 services.
- 29 The bill excludes video programming offered by a provider
- 30 of direct-to-home satellite services as video service. The
- 31 bill also excludes digital audio-visual works offered over the
- 32 internet as video service.
- 33 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
