SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO.

BY (PROPOSED COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENT RESOLUTION BY CHAIRPERSON SWEENEY) 1 A Concurrent Resolution designating the American cream draft horse as the official state horse of the State 2 3 of Iowa. WHEREAS, the American cream draft horse is the only 4 5 draft horse breed native to the United States; and WHEREAS, the American cream draft horse is a breed 6 7 that traces its bloodline back to a mare named "Old 8 Granny", which is believed to have been foaled in Iowa 9 around the turn of the last century, first appearing 10 in records from a farm sale in the city of Jewell, in 11 Story county, Iowa, in 1911; and WHEREAS, the breed was recognized by the Iowa 12 13 department of agriculture in 1950, based on a 1948 14 recommendation by the national stallion enrollment 15 board; and 16 WHEREAS, in 1944, the American cream horse 17 association of America was chartered by Mr. C.T. 18 Rierson, and his assistant Mrs. Karene (Bunker) Topp, 19 of Radcliffe, Iowa, the culmination of almost 40 years 20 of interest in creating a new breed of American draft 21 horse; and WHEREAS, in 1993, members of the organization voted 22 23 to amend the organization's articles of incorporation 24 to change its name to the American cream draft horse 25 association; and 26 WHEREAS, the American cream draft horse is

27 immediately identifiable by its cream coat, pink skin,

1 and amber-colored eyes, specific traits of the famous 2 champagne dilution gene; and WHEREAS, in 1990, genetic testing found that, 3 4 compared with other draft breeds and based upon gene 5 marker data, the American cream draft horse formed a 6 distinct group within the draft horses; and WHEREAS, the breed is closely associated with 7 8 Iowa's farming heritage — having a wide chest; 9 sloping shoulders; a short, strong back; well-muscled 10 hindquarters with strong, well-proportioned 11 legs set well apart; strong hooves; and a gentle 12 disposition; NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF 13 14 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, That the American cream 15 draft horse is designated and shall be officially known 16 as the state horse of Iowa; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the director of the 17 18 department of cultural affairs is directed to cooperate 19 with the American cream draft horse association to 20 obtain appropriate pictures and other representations 21 of the American cream draft horse and shall display the 22 pictures and representations in an appropriate place in 23 the state historical museum; and 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the editor of the Iowa 25 official register is directed to cooperate with the 26 American cream draft horse association to include an 27 appropriate picture and commentary of the American 28 cream draft horse in the Iowa official register along 29 with the pictures of the state rock, state flower, 30 state bird, and state tree.
