Senate Study Bill 3063 - Introduced

- 1 An Act relating to building requirements for factory-built
 2 structures.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 103A.3, Code 2024, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsections:

3 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 3A. "*Commercial modular structure*" means a 4 factory-built structure built for use as a commercial structure 5 and not as a single-family or two-family dwelling unit.

6 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 16A. "*Manufactured home community*" means a 7 location with three or more sequential lots with manufactured 8 homes installed for habitation.

9 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 16B. *Mobile home park* means a location 10 with three or more sequential lots with mobile homes installed 11 for habitation.

12 NEW SUBSECTION. 19A. "Park model home" means a

13 factory-built structure which is used as a residential dwelling 14 and which complies with the American national standard for park 15 model recreational vehicles, commonly cited as "ANSI A 119.5".

16 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 26. *"Tiny home"* means a factory-built 17 structure of less than three hundred twenty square feet that is 18 used as a residential dwelling.

19 Sec. 2. Section 103A.3, subsection 10, Code 2024, is amended 20 to read as follows:

10. *Factory-built structure* means any structure which x wholly or in substantial part, made, fabricated, formed, assembled in manufacturing facilities for installation, or assembly and installation, on a building site. *Factory-built structure* includes the terms *mobile home*, *manufactured home*, <u>*commercial modular structure*</u>, *tiny home*, *park model home*, and *modular home*.

28 Sec. 3. Section 103A.9, subsection 1, Code 2024, is amended 29 by adding the following new paragraphs:

30 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. *f.* Commercial modular structures must comply 31 with the code. Anchoring and support of commercial modular 32 structures must be designed by a licensed architect or licensed 33 engineer and must at a minimum comply with 24 C.F.R. pt. 3285. 34 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. *g.* Tiny homes of two hundred square feet 35 or more of dwelling space must comply with safety requirements

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1 listed in the code. The code does not apply to tiny homes of 2 less than two hundred square feet of dwelling space.

3 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. *h*. Park model homes must be supported and 4 anchored in accordance with 24 C.F.R. pt. 3285 or 661 IAC ch. 5 322.

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EXPLANATION

9 This bill relates to building requirements for factory-built 10 structures. The bill defines "manufactured home community" 11 and "mobile home park" as a location with three or more 12 sequential lots containing manufactured homes or mobile homes, 13 respectively, that are used for habitation. The bill also 14 defines three types of factory-built structures: "commercial 15 modular structure", "park model home", and "tiny home". The bill requires commercial modular structures to comply 16 17 with the state building code and include anchoring and support 18 systems designed by a licensed architect or licensed engineer 19 in compliance with 24 C.F.R. pt. 3285. Tiny homes of 200 20 square feet or more of dwelling space must comply with safety 21 requirements of the state building code, but the state building 22 code does not apply to tiny homes of less than 200 square feet 23 of dwelling space. The bill also requires park model homes to 24 be supported and anchored in accordance with 24 C.F.R. pt. 3285 25 or 661 IAC ch. 322.

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
