A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to software security measures for text
- 2 messages, providing penalties, and including effective date
- 3 provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 476.95C Software security measures 2 for text messages.
- 3 l. For the purposes of this section:
- 4 a. "Encrypted" means the same as defined in section 715C.1.
- 5 b. "Texting software" means the software that comes
- 6 preloaded on a wireless device, and any subsequent updates to
- 7 the software, that enables the wireless device to send a text
- 8 message to or receive a text message from all or substantially
- 9 all United States telephone numbers capable of sending or
- 10 receiving a text message.
- 11 c. "Texting software provider" means an entity that provides
- 12 texting software to a wireless device.
- 2. When a person sends a text message to or receives a
- 14 text message from an individual or a group using the texting
- 15 software on a wireless device, the texting software provider
- 16 for the wireless device sending the text message shall ensure
- 17 all of the following:
- 18 a. That the data sent in the text message is encrypted
- 19 and that the texting software selects a network that is
- 20 compatible with and supports such encryption when selecting
- 21 a communication network to send the text message to another
- 22 wireless device.
- 23 b. A photo, video, or other media sent in the text message
- 24 is sent in its original quality without degradation.
- c. That the person who sent the text message receives a
- 26 real-time notification that the recipient of the text message
- 27 has viewed it, if the text message recipient has enabled such a
- 28 notification function on the wireless device.
- d. That the intended recipient of a text message is sent
- 30 a real-time notification that a person is typing text, if the
- 31 text message sender has enabled such a notification function
- 32 on the wireless device.
- 33 3. a. The board or the attorney general may bring an action
- 34 against a texting software provider that has violated this
- 35 chapter and may seek a temporary or permanent injunction to

1 restrain the violation.

- 2 b. A texting software provider that violates this section
- 3 is subject to a civil penalty of ten dollars per violation for
- 4 each device with which a violation occurs. Each calendar month
- 5 a violation occurs constitutes a separate violation for each
- 6 device with which a violation occurs.
- 7 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 8 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 9 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 12 This bill requires texting software providers to ensure
- 13 certain encryption and notification features when persons
- 14 send or receive text messages. "Texting software provider"
- 15 is defined in the bill as an entity that provides software
- 16 that comes preloaded on a wireless device, and any subsequent
- 17 updates to the software, that enables the wireless device to
- 18 send or receive a text message from U.S. telephone numbers
- 19 capable of sending or receiving a text message. The bill
- 20 requires a texting software provider to ensure that text
- 21 message data is encrypted and sent over a network that supports
- 22 the encryption, that media sent in the text message is sent
- 23 and received in its original quality without degradation, and
- 24 that a text message sender or receiver receives real-time
- 25 notifications that a person is typing a message or whether
- 26 a sent message has been read, if the user has enabled such
- 27 functions on the wireless device.
- 28 The bill authorizes the Iowa utilities board and the
- 29 attorney general to seek an injunction against a software
- 30 provider that is not encrypting text messages. A violation
- 31 of the bill subjects the texting software provider to a civil
- 32 penalty of \$10 for each device with which a violation occurs.
- 33 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
