A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to software security measures for text
2 messages, providing penalties, and including effective date
3 provisions.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 476.95C Software security measures
2 for text messages.

3 1. For the purposes of this section:

4 a. "Encrypted" means the same as defined in section 715C.1.

5 b. "Texting software" means the software that comes
6 preloaded on a wireless device, and any subsequent updates to
7 the software, that enables the wireless device to send a text
8 message to or receive a text message from all or substantially
9 all United States telephone numbers capable of sending or
10 receiving a text message.

11 c. "Texting software provider" means an entity that provides
12 texting software to a wireless device.

13 2. When a person sends a text message to or receives a
14 text message from an individual or a group using the texting
15 software on a wireless device, the texting software provider
16 for the wireless device sending the text message shall ensure
17 all of the following:

18 a. That the data sent in the text message is encrypted
19 and that the texting software selects a network that is
20 compatible with and supports such encryption when selecting
21 a communication network to send the text message to another
22 wireless device.

23 b. A photo, video, or other media sent in the text message
24 is sent in its original quality without degradation.

25 c. That the person who sent the text message receives a
26 real-time notification that the recipient of the text message
27 has viewed it, if the text message recipient has enabled such a
28 notification function on the wireless device.

29 d. That the intended recipient of a text message is sent
30 a real-time notification that a person is typing text, if the
31 text message sender has enabled such a notification function
32 on the wireless device.

33 3. a. The board or the attorney general may bring an action
34 against a texting software provider that has violated this
35 chapter and may seek a temporary or permanent injunction to
