- An Act relating to city libraries, including library directors
 and library projects and initiatives.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 392.5, Code 2024, is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 392.5 Library board.

a. A city library board of trustees functioning on the
 effective date of the city code shall continue to function in
 the same manner until altered or discontinued as provided in
 this section.

8 b. In order for the board to function in the same manner, 9 the council shall retain all applicable ordinances, and shall 10 adopt as ordinances all applicable state statutes repealed by 11 1972 Iowa Acts, ch. 1088.

A library board may accept and control the expenditure of
 all gifts, devises, and bequests to the library.

14 3. a. A proposal to alter the composition, manner of 15 selection, or charge of a library board, or to replace it with 16 an alternate form of administrative agency, is subject to the 17 approval of the voters of the city.

18 b. The proposal may be submitted to the voters at any city 19 election by the council on its own motion. Upon receipt of a 20 valid petition as defined in section 362.4, requesting that a 21 proposal be submitted to the voters, the council shall submit 22 the proposal at the next regular city election. A proposal 23 submitted to the voters must describe with reasonable detail

24 the action proposed.

25 c. If a majority of those voting approves the proposal, the 26 city may proceed as proposed.

27 *d.* If a majority of those voting does not approve the

28 proposal, the same or a similar proposal may not be submitted

29 to the voters of the city for at least four years from the date

30 of the election at which the proposal was defeated. A council

31 may oversee and change the practice related to hiring a library

32 director and utilize moneys collected pursuant to section

33 8A.222 for library projects and initiatives by ordinance and

3 This bill relates to city library directors and city library 4 policies and initiatives.

5 Under current law, a city council may, on its own motion, 6 or shall, upon receipt of a valid petition, submit a proposal 7 to alter the composition, selection process, or charge of the 8 library board to the voters of the city. The bill strikes this 9 provision and allows a city council to oversee and change the 10 hiring practice for a library director and utilize library tax 11 moneys for library projects and initiatives by ordinance and 12 without a referendum.
