**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to community-based providers in the statewide  
2 voluntary preschool program for four-year-old children.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 256C.3, subsection 4, Code 2026, is  
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. e. (1) A school district may enter into a  
4 chapter 28E agreement with a community-based provider to allow  
5 the community-based provider to provide high-quality instruction  
6 as part of the approved local program.

7 (2) Upon the request of a community-based provider, a school  
8 district shall enter into a chapter 28E agreement with a  
9 community-based provider to allow the community-based provider to  
10 provide high-quality instruction as part of the approved local  
11 program.

12 (3) A chapter 28E agreement entered into pursuant to this  
13 paragraph shall not limit the number of eligible students who may  
14 receive high-quality instruction from a community-based provider  
15 as part of the approved local program.

16 EXPLANATION

17 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with  
18 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

19 This bill relates to community-based providers in the  
20 statewide voluntary preschool program for four-year-old children.  
21 The bill authorizes school districts to enter into a Code  
22 chapter 28E agreement with a community-based provider allowing  
23 the community-based provider to provide instruction as part  
24 of the approved local program, and the bill requires school  
25 districts to enter into such an agreement upon the request of a  
26 community-based provider. Additionally, the bill prohibits such  
27 Code chapter 28E agreements from limiting the number of eligible  
28 students who may receive instruction from a community-based  
29 provider as part of the approved local program.
