A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to forms of payment for entry into
2 an extracurricular interscholastic athletic contest or
3 competition.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. **280.13H Extracurricular**
2 **interscholastic athletic contests or competitions — acceptance**
3 **of legal tender required.**

4 1. For purposes of this section, "organization" means the
5 same as defined in section 280.13.

6 2. A public school shall accept legal tender as a form
7 of payment for entry into any extracurricular interscholastic
8 athletic contest or competition sponsored by an organization.
9 As a condition of registration with the department of education
10 under section 280.13, an organization shall accept legal tender
11 as a form of payment for entry into any extracurricular
12 interscholastic athletic contest or competition sponsored by the
13 organization.

14 3. This section shall not apply to extracurricular
15 interscholastic athletic contests or competitions that take place
16 at schools that are not members of an organization.

17 **EXPLANATION**

18 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
19 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

20 This bill relates to forms of payment for entry into an
21 extracurricular interscholastic athletic contest or competition.
22 The bill requires a public school to accept legal tender
23 as a form of payment for entry into any extracurricular
24 interscholastic athletic contest or competition sponsored by
25 an extracurricular interscholastic athletic organization. The
26 bill requires an extracurricular interscholastic athletic
27 organization, as a condition of registration with the department
28 of education, to accept legal tender as a form of payment for
29 entry into an extracurricular interscholastic athletic contest or
30 competition sponsored by the organization.

31 The bill does not apply to extracurricular interscholastic
32 athletic contests or competitions that take place at schools that
33 are not members of an organization.
