A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to certain city fire protection and emergency
- 2 medical services funds.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. **384.12A Fire protection and**
2 **emergency medical services fund.**

3 1. If a city provides fire protection or emergency medical
4 service to another city or to a township pursuant to a contract
5 or under an agreement pursuant to chapter 28E, the city shall
6 establish a fire protection and emergency medical services fund.
7 Moneys in the fund shall be used only for costs of providing fire
8 protection and emergency medical services to the other cities or
9 to the portions of such townships outside the corporate limits of
10 the city, as applicable.

11 2. The full amount of moneys received from a township for
12 fire protection or emergency medical services provided pursuant
13 to the contract or agreement under chapter 28E shall be credited
14 to the fire protection and emergency medical services fund.

15 3. The full amount of moneys received from another city
16 under a contract to provide fire protection or emergency medical
17 services or under an agreement pursuant to chapter 28E shall be
18 credited to the fire protection and emergency medical services
19 fund.

20 4. Balances in a fire protection and emergency medical
21 services fund at the end of a fiscal year shall remain in the
22 fund for use under this section in future fiscal years.

23 **EXPLANATION**

24 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
25 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

26 Cities may contract with other public agencies to provide fire
27 protection and emergency medical services. This bill requires
28 cities that contract with other cities or a township to provide
29 such protection and services to establish a fire protection and
30 emergency medical services fund, in which all moneys received
31 from such townships and other cities for fire protection and
32 emergency medical services shall be credited. Moneys in the
33 fund shall be used only for providing fire protection and
34 emergency medical services to the other cities or the portions
35 of such townships outside the corporate limits of the city, as

1 applicable. Any balances in a fire protection and emergency
2 medical services fund at the end of a fiscal year shall remain
3 in the fund.
