A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the membership of the Iowa law enforcement
2 academy council.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 80B.6, subsection 1, paragraphs a, h, and
2 i, Code 2026, are amended to read as follows:

3 a. ~~Three residents~~ One resident of the state who has not been
4 employed as a certified law enforcement officer.

5 h. A police officer who is a member of a police department of
6 a city with a population of ~~fifty~~ five thousand persons or more.

7 i. A police officer who is a member of a police department
8 of a city with a population of less than ~~fifty~~ five thousand
9 persons.

10 Sec. 2. Section 80B.6, subsection 1, Code 2026, is amended by
11 adding the following new paragraphs:

12 NEW PARAGRAPH. l. A member of the Iowa fraternal order of
13 police.

14 NEW PARAGRAPH. m. A police officer employed by a regents
15 institution.

16 Sec. 3. Section 80B.6, Code 2026, is amended by adding the
17 following new subsection:

18 NEW SUBSECTION. 4. No person shall be eligible to serve on
19 the Iowa law enforcement academy council for more than two terms
20 in succession.

21 EXPLANATION

22 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
23 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

24 This bill relates to the membership of the Iowa law
25 enforcement academy council.

26 The bill provides that one member of the council must
27 be a resident of the state who has not been employed as a
28 certified law enforcement officer and two additional officers are
29 designated to replace two residents of the state.

30 The bill provides that one member shall be a police officer
31 who is a member of a police department of a city with a
32 population of 5,000 persons or more, and one member shall be
33 a police officer who is a member of a police department of a
34 city with a population of less than 5,000 persons. Current law
35 specifies a population of 50,000 or more, and 50,000 or less,

1 respectively.

2 The bill provides that no person is eligible to serve on the
3 Iowa law enforcement academy council for more than two terms in
4 succession.
