A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to a standing appropriation to the department
2 of health and human services to make free radon test kits
3 available to homeowners and renters in the state.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. **136B.6 Radon test kits —**
2 **appropriation.**

3 1. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending
4 June 30, 2026, and for each fiscal year thereafter, there is
5 appropriated from the general fund of the state to the department
6 of health and human services the amount of twenty thousand
7 dollars to be used to make radon test kits available, free of
8 charge, to homeowners and renters in the state.

9 2. The department shall designate a radon testing laboratory
10 to supply, distribute, and analyze radon test kits. To be
11 the laboratory designated by the department, the radon testing
12 laboratory must agree to provide data obtained from analysis of
13 the radon test kits to the department upon request.

14 3. The department shall provide a link on the department's
15 internet site for homeowners and renters in the state to order
16 radon test kits.

17 **EXPLANATION**

18 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
19 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

20 This bill provides a standing appropriation of \$20,000 from
21 the general fund of the state to the department of health and
22 human services (HHS) beginning FY 2025-2026, to make free radon
23 test kits available to homeowners and renters in the state. HHS
24 shall designate a radon testing laboratory to supply, distribute,
25 and analyze radon test kits. To be designated by HHS, the
26 laboratory must agree to provide data analyzed from the radon
27 test kits upon request. HHS shall provide a link on HHS's
28 internet site for members of the public to order a radon test
29 kit.
