A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to medical residency and fellowship positions,
2 and certain medical residency and fellowship position
3 applicants.
4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. MEDICAL RESIDENCY POSITIONS AND AUDITION CLINICALS
2 — MEDICAL STUDENTS AND APPLICANTS MEETING CERTAIN CRITERIA —
3 ANNUAL REPORT.

4 1. The university of Iowa hospitals and clinics shall offer
5 an interview for an available medical residency position to
6 any applicant who has a residency specialty in obstetrics and
7 gynecology, psychiatry, general surgery, emergency medicine,
8 neurology, or primary care, or an available cardiology fellowship
9 position to any applicant who has a fellowship specialty in
10 cardiology, and who also is a resident of Iowa, attended
11 and earned an undergraduate degree from an Iowa college or
12 university, or attended and earned a medical degree from a
13 medical school in Iowa.

14 2. The university of Iowa hospitals and clinics shall submit
15 a report to the governor and the general assembly by January
16 15, annually, regarding the interviews as specified in this
17 section during the prior fiscal year. Specifically, the report
18 shall include for each interview the name of the applicant's
19 medical school, whether an applicant was offered and participated
20 in an interview, whether the applicant was accepted for one
21 of the residency or fellowship positions, and the total number
22 of available residency and fellowship positions filled by an
23 applicant meeting the criteria under this section.

24 EXPLANATION

25 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
26 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

27 This bill requires the university of Iowa hospitals and
28 clinics (UIHC) to offer an interview for an available medical
29 residency position to any applicant who has a residency specialty
30 in obstetrics and gynecology, psychiatry, general surgery,
31 neurology, or primary care, or an available cardiology fellowship
32 position to any applicant who has a fellowship specialty in
33 cardiology, and who is also a resident of Iowa, attended
34 and earned an undergraduate degree from an Iowa college or
35 university, or attended and earned a medical degree from a

1 medical school in Iowa.

2 The UIHC shall annually submit a report to the governor
3 and the general assembly by January 15 containing information
4 regarding the interviews as detailed in the bill.
