A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to drug paraphernalia, and providing penalties.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 124.414, subsection 3, Code 2025, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 3. A person who violates this section commits a simple
4 misdemeanor punishable as a scheduled violation under section
5 805.8C.

6 Sec. 2. Section 124.414, Code 2025, is amended by adding the
7 following new subsection:

8 NEW SUBSECTION. 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of
9 law, a violation of this section shall not be used to enhance any
10 other controlled substance violation under this chapter.

11 Sec. 3. Section 805.8C, Code 2025, is amended by adding the
12 following new subsection:

13 NEW SUBSECTION. 3A. *Drug paraphernalia violations*. For
14 violations of section 124.414, the scheduled fine is two hundred
15 sixty dollars.

16 EXPLANATION

17 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
18 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

19 This bill relates to drug paraphernalia.

20 Under current law, a person who knowingly or intentionally
21 manufactures, delivers, sells, or possesses drug paraphernalia
22 commits a simple misdemeanor. A simple misdemeanor is punishable
23 by confinement for no more than 30 days and a fine of at least
24 \$105 but not more than \$855. The bill makes the violation a
25 simple misdemeanor punishable as a scheduled violation resulting
26 in a fine of \$260.

27 The bill provides that notwithstanding any other provision
28 of law, the manufacture, delivery, sale, or possession of drug
29 paraphernalia shall not be used to enhance any other controlled
30 substance violation under Code chapter 124.
